What is Safe Routes for Seniors?

Safe Routes for Seniors is an LADOT initiative focused on older adults (those ages 65 and older).

Between 2023 and 2025, LADOT is piloting five neighborhood plans in that will include transportation safety and quality of life improvements to key neighborhood destinations for older adults.

The plans may include recommendations like crossing improvements, shade and cooling, and space for people to ride their bikes.

Project Goals:

- **Eliminate crashes that lead to deaths and serious injuries** for older adults
- **Increase the number of trips made by walking and bicycling** for older adults
- **Reduce isolation and improve health outcomes** for older adults
- **Empower older adults** to identify transportation needs in their neighborhoods and provide input in city planning processes
