congregation to have an eldership—not just any group of men, but qualified men doing their best to serve God as shepherds. I think you know it, but we are extremely blessed to have the elders we do at North Hamilton. Not every congregation has what we have, and we should thank God for it. But I wonder if perhaps this is where our prayers stop. We give thanks frequently that we have elders, and ask God to bless them. And we should be doing this every day. But do we think about what is really involved in being an elder in the church? Maybe if we knew what they bear daily, our appreciation would deepen for the men that desire this enormous and important work in the Lord's kingdom. Here are a few things for us to ponder:

- 1. Elders work more than just on Sundays and Wednesdays—a lot more. Sure, we see them at every worship service. And we should. Elders are to be faithful men (1 Tim. 3:1-7), and as such they are going to be where God's people are gathered together. However, there is no day off for an elder. They sacrifice time from their personal lives regularly to meet, counsel, study with and listen to members. They are on-call 24/7.
- 2. Elders understand that they will answer to God in judgment for their work. The writer of Hebrews makes that clear (Heb. 13:17). God calls for the highest caliber men to serve in this position and judges accordingly. These are the men tasked with protecting the Lord's bride (Tit. 1:9-11), and surely that responsibility weighs on them daily.
