1. What is Paul's desire for men (1 Tim. 2:8)? Is "men" generic or gender-specific? What does this mean? Also, is this desire limited only to prayer or does it include other actions of worship? What is this verse telling us about the public mixed-gendered assemblies?
2. What should we make of the request for women (2:9-10)? Is this simply about dress or is there something deeper being addressed? What is it?
3. Many people struggle to understand the differences in the roles of men and women in the church. How are we to understand the role of women, according to Scripture (2:11-15)?
