1. From a human perspective, how difficult must it have been for Hosea to take back Gomer (v. 1)? Why is this so hard, even today? What did God have Hosea do this? What was the message?

2. What is the principle in Hosea 3:2? Why was money paid to buy her back? How does this work in the big picture of our salvation?

3. What is Hosea asking of Gomer in Hosea 3:3? Applying this to our situation today, what does this mean for us?

4. How do you understand Hosea 3:4-5? What is the goodness they will experience in "the latter days?"
