Discussion Questions

1. Are people responsible for what they do, even if leaders are justifying bad behavior (v. 1-3)? Do people seem to justify bad behavior by blaming others? Explain. Is this a problem even today?

2. How do we know that God holds leaders accountable too (v. 4-10)? How can we incorporate this lesson into the church today?

3. What does it mean that people are destroy "for lack of knowledge?" Do some research on the word "knowledge." What level of knowledge is God talking about here?

4. God mocks idolatry (v. 11-19). How does He do this and what is His point? What lesson can we take from this about the purity of our devotion to God?
