First, the explanation is rather easy. We have for many years disregarded the sanctity of life. All persons are made in the very image of God (Gen. 1:26-28). That truth should shape the way we treat our fellow man, including those that are still in the womb. We ought to hate the "hands that shed innocent blood" (Prov. 6:17). When we accepted the practice of abortion as the status quo, we sent a message that life isn't important if it conflicts with our own personal agenda. We have also perverted human sexuality. The same from-the-beginning principles also define human sexual relations. It is part of marriage (Gen. 1:26-28; 2:18-25; 4:1). The body is fearfully and wonderfully made (Psa. 139:14), including our sexual desires and capabilities. Our capacity for sexual intimacy is ordained by God to be reserved for our marital partner (1 Cor. 7:1-9). But when we stop respecting life and pervert sexuality it results in a dangerous concoction that sees other people (even children, for some) as mere objects to satisfy carnal cravings.

Second, we must stop sexualizing our children. Obviously we may not be able to change the heart of every person but we are not helping the problem at all when we present our children as sexual objects. It is one thing to talk with our children about marriage and sexuality. We should. They should learn that "marriage is honorable among all, and the bed undefiled" (Heb. 13:4). They must learn that their body is fearfully and wonderfully made (Psa. 139:14) and to be saved for their future spouse. They should learn that God cares about modesty and that real beauty is the submission of the heart to our Maker (1 Pet. 3:1-7).

It is another thing entirely when we feed perverse forms of sexuality to our children. What outcome are we hoping for from our kids and the world when we feed our children songs and movies that present children as desirable objects (Mark 7:21-23; Phil. 4:8)? What are we expecting when we let our girls and boys dress inappropriately (1 Tim. 2:9-10)? Are we so surprised at what's happening when we post pictures of our children in skimpy clothing in public sites like Facebook (Matt. 5:28)? As an example, Netflix will soon be offering a series about preteen girls learning how to dirty dance! The only way all this madness can be brought to an end is for parents to stop sexualizing their children.

Obviously, you can tell I am bothered by what's happening. Our world is sick and it scares me to death that children are now at risk because of it. But so much of this could be ended if we started teaching Biblical sexuality to our children instead of Satan's version. "Jesus loves the little children of the world", we sing. In the purest and most protective way, He does. We should too.
