Discussion Questions

1. What happens to Pharaoh just after the children of Israel leave Egypt (Exo. 14:1–8)? Why do you think this happened? What is his motivation for pursuing Israel?
2. How did the people react to the news that Egypt was after them (Exo. 14:9–18)? Were their accusations justified or should they have had a different response? What does it seem they have forgotten? Is there a lesson here for us?
3. What initial actions does God take to delay the Egyptian army (Exo. 14:19–20)? What should the people have learned from this?

4. The parting of the Red Sea is one of the most memorable and amazing miracles recorded in Scripture (Exo. 14:21–31). What happens?

5. What can we learn from the songs of Moses and Miriam in Exodus 15:1-21?

6. Why is the end of Exodus 15 so tragic (spiritually)?
