Discussion Questions

1. What should we take away from the "if/then" statements of the Bible, like the one in Exodus 8:2? Is God justified in placing consequences on certain behavior? Why? Can you think of some other statements like this that apply today, where God conditions our choices with consequences?

2. How widespread was the plague of frogs? What were the effects of the plague? How did the plague end?

3. What are lice? Why would this plague have been so devastating in the culture of Egypt?

4. What was the end result of the plague (8:18-19)?
