PARENTS AND/OR GUARDIANS OF STUDENT ATHLETES, PLEASE READ THE FOLLOWING COMMITMENTS CAREFULLY AND, IF IN AGREEMENT, PLEASE SIGN.

LKY MISSION

LKY exists to provide Christian competitive athletic opportunities for homeschool families that live in or near the Louisville area.

LKY VISION

LKY desires to teach student-athletes how to honor Christ and compete in their sport. Our vision is to build sports programs and not simply individual teams. This allows the homeschool athlete to grow up in a program under the same Christian organization for all of the years they participate in a sport.

I understand that it is LKY’s purpose for Jesus Christ to be glorified in all activities associated with LKY Homeschool Athletics program. I also understand that my child’s participation is a family commitment, therefore, I commit myself to:

- Being courteous and submitting to officials regardless of the calls. No verbal or nonverbal demonstrations of disrespect.
- Being courteous and deferring to the coach’s decisions concerning the sport, including decisions about playing time in conjunction with the LKY Playing Time Policy, as well as the coach’s approach to practices and competitions. Rather than approaching the coach myself, I will encourage my child to bring any questions or concerns to his/her coach directly.
- Being courteous and showing respect toward my child’s teammates and coaches, any opponents, and all fans at all times.
- Building up, encouraging, and seeking unity with fellow LKY families, and not creating division through gossip, teasing, grumbling, bullying, and other dishonoring speech.
- Being modest in victory and gracious in defeat.
- Striving to have my child at all practices and games on time, and if practice or competition must be missed, notifying my child’s coach at least 24 hours in advance whenever possible.
- Helping my child prioritize team commitment over other social activities.
- Refraining from the use of God's name in vain, profanity, and other corrupting speech, which does not build up others or fit the occasion.
- Refraining from illegal drug use and/or any other illegal activities at all times. While at LKY events, I will refrain from drinking alcoholic beverages.
- Abiding by all posted rules and regulations at all venues where my child represents LKY.
- Being respectful by not interfering with, nor undermining, LKY’s Mission, Vision, and/or Statement of Faith, while upholding the reputation of the organization during my child’s participation in the program.

I understand that if I fail to abide by this code of conduct, the organization leadership has the authority to dismiss my family from the program and I will not be entitled to any refund.
