Notice the NASB says "magi" (not "wise men"). The word in Greek is μάγοι (magoi) - where we get the word ""

Answers: Persian, Astronomers, interpreters, divination, kingmakers
3. The Zoroastrian Connection

4. Daniel's Influence
became the chief of the magicians, enchanters, Chaldeans, and astrologers in Babylon (Daniel 5:11). Answer: Daniel

5. The Prophecies They Followed
Daniel 9:25 - The Timeline
 "From the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks"
• 69 "weeks" of years = years from the decree to rebuild Jerusalem to the Messiah's coming (69x7) Answer: 483
Numbers 24:17 Balaam's Prophecy: The Star
"A shall come forth from Jacob, A shall rise from Israel"
Answers: star, scepter
6. The Journey Distance: Over miles from Persia to Judea
Answer: 1,000
Travel time: months Answer: 2-3
Preparation time: months Answer: 2-6
Total time: Could have been a or more from when they first saw the star Answer: year

7. Two Years and Under
Herod asked the Magi: "What did the star appear?" (Matthew 2:7) Answer: time
Based on their answer, Herod killed all boys years old and under (Matthew 2:16).
Answer: two
8. The Contrast
The Magi:
Traveled over miles
Spent months preparing and traveling
Jesus when they found Him. Answers: 1,000, worshiped
The Jewish scribes:
• Knew the (Micah 5:2)
Were only miles away in Jerusalem
Never went
Answers: prophecy, six, looking (or "to Bethlehem")
The Challenge
Are we like the?
People who know the Bible but miss Jesus because He doesn't show up the way we expect
Answer: scribes
Or are we like the?
Willing to seek, willing to journey, willing to worship even when it costs something
Answer: Magi
