COMMUNION

At Coastal, we offer communion every Sunday. It is also known as the Lord's Supper or Eucharist, which symbolizes Jesus' sacrifice for humanity's sins and establishes a new covenant between God and believers.

The Elements: The bread (cracker) represents the body of Jesus which was broken for you. The wine (grapejuice) represents the blood of Jesus which was poured out for the forgiveness of your sins.

Formal Communion: On the 1st Sunday of the month we have a formal time of communion where a pastor leads the congregation and explains this church ordinance. Everyone who is a follower of Christ, will partake of it together when we are instructed by the pastor.


Additional Sundays: On the other Sundays, we have a self-serve style of communion after the sermon. There will be a table with the elements on it, and every follower of Jesus will be able to walk up and partake, during the final song. We make communion available weekly because we are instructed to do this as often as we will (1 Corinthians 11:26).

Who can take communion? Any believer in Jesus, regardless of your church denomination or communion tradition. If you have accepted Jesus as your Lord and Savior and follow Him, we welcome you to partake of the elements with us. However, before you partake, Christ followers are told to examine themselves (1 Corinthians 11:28-29) to make sure our hearts are prepared to honor Jesus.
