COMMUNION

At Coastal, we offer communion every Sunday — also known as the Lord's Supper or Eucharist — symbolizing Jesus' sacrifice and the new covenant between God and believers.

The Elements: The bread (cracker) represents the body of Jesus, broken for you. The wine (grape juice) represents His blood, poured out for the forgiveness of your sins.

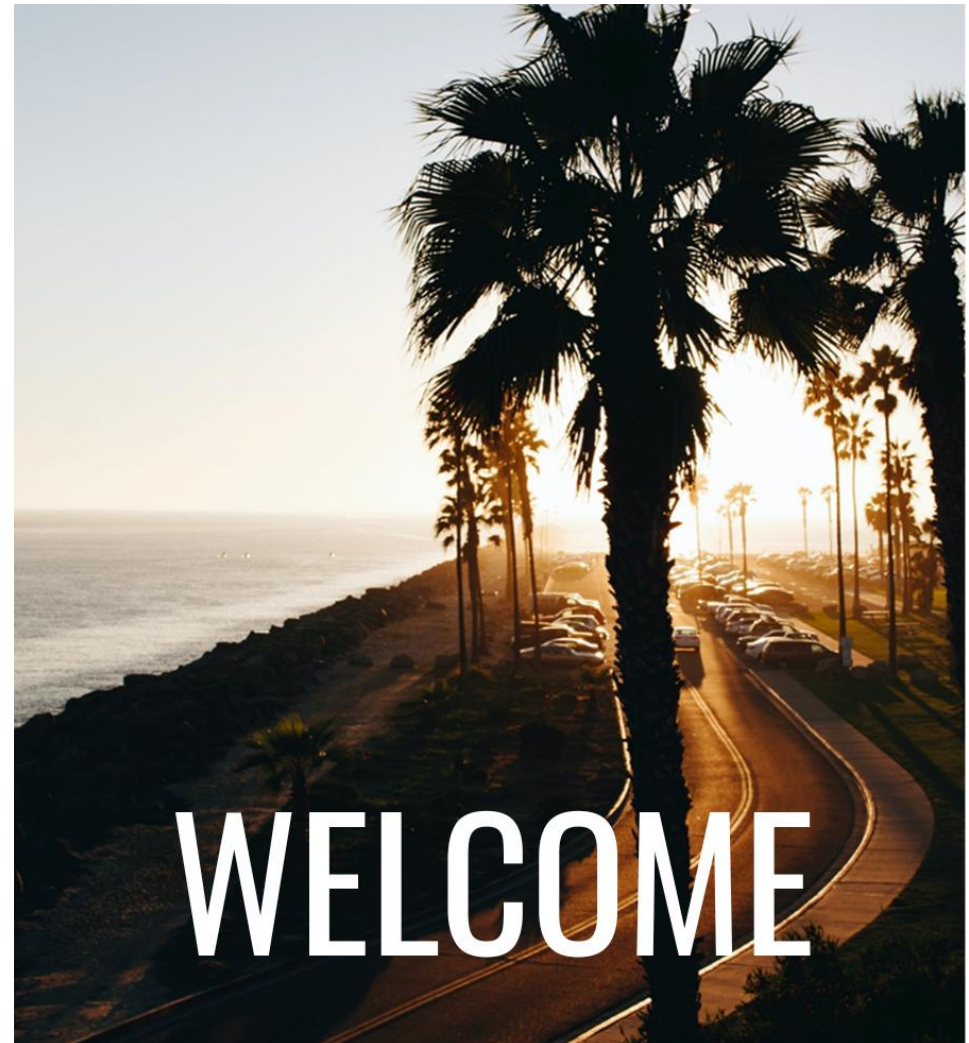
1st Sunday: A pastor leads a formal communion time, explaining this ordinance. All followers of Christ partake together at the pastor's instruction.

Other Sundays: After the sermon, communion is self-serve. During the final song, a table with the elements is available for every follower of Jesus to walk up and partake. We offer communion weekly because we are instructed to do so "as often as you will" (1 Corinthians 11:26).

Who Can Participate? Any believer in Jesus, regardless of denomination or tradition. If you have accepted Jesus as Lord and Savior, you are welcome at the Table.

Children & Communion: The Lord's Table is open to all who trust in Christ. Like the Passover, it is a family meal. Parents are best positioned to discern when their children are ready. Talk with your child about what communion means — Jesus' body broken and blood shed for our sins — and invite them when they show genuine faith and basic understanding. No age requirement is mandated.
