I write to you from my own parents' home as we prepare for a rather unusual Thanksgiving Holiday. One in which some of our usual traditions will be put on hold in favor of a simpler meal and giving genuine thanks for good medical care for my dad. I realize how some years are like this. The familiarity of a holiday or tradition gets pushed into unfamiliar territory by changing circumstances. Children grow up, families grow and change, loved ones move away or die, and we find ourselves in liminal space. The end of one thing, without knowing exactly what is about to begin.

Advent is a time that can be exceptionally meaningful in exactly these kinds of liminal years. As a congregation, we are in an uncomfortably liminal moment. Much of what has been is coming to a close, and while we wait and trust and hope that something new and good is just around the corner, we can't see it. We don't know yet just exactly what that new life will look like.

And so we wait, in hopeful expectation, for what comes next. Our Christian tradition says it will likely look something like Hope, Peace, Joy, Love, and the inbreaking of the Kingdom of God through the Incarnation- God with us.
