SPPRC is completing its annual Leadership Assessment form for the district, which explores church vitality. Even in the pandemic, our church sustains vital ministries and moves God's people closer to God. This is a good chance for us all to reflect on the goals we set as a congregation two years ago: to get more people involved in small groups; to get more people involved in missional outreach; and to bring our church attendance demographics closer to matching the demographics of Baldwin City. We can all help our church achieve these goals. The best means is by inviting a friend or acquaintance to join in a worship service online or in person, to attend a small group meeting, and to share in God's work in our community. And don't just invite - follow through!

We continue to invite volunteers to help the church run smoothly. Here are our needs for April into May, with a little more detail than usual:

 Help disinfect key spaces between worship services, specifically, the pew cards, elevator buttons and rails, doorknobs, and light switches. This should take less than an hour. Disinfecting supplies are at the church. Please sign up for this a week at a time;

- Disinfecting the back of the pews, once during the last week of April (April 26-30). This takes around 45 minutes for one person;
- Sending birthday cards for a month. This involves addressing, enveloping writing a message in the cards, and mailing. There are around 20 per month. Cards, envelopes, and stamps are provided;
- Mentors to pray for our 3 rd and 4th graders as they receive bibles in April, and for our youth as the church prepares for confirmation;
- People to be certified for Safe Gatherings. This is for anyone who does or will work with children or youth;
- Cleaning parts of the church. Since we are eliminating our current cleaning service, we are in need of volunteers to fill the gap while the trustees determine the next best step for the care of our building. These will likely be one-space / one-time opportunities (e.g., vacuum and dust the Chapel in the first week of July). Stay tuned for specifics;
- Need mowers for the grounds around the church:
- And in future months: Volunteers to help with summer Vacation Bible School. Details TBD, but there will be many things to do!

By now, hopefully, you have noted the worship time change to 9:30 a.m. on Sunday Morning. The adult Sunday School class (Journey's) will still meet at after morning worship with KID Ministry (grades K-5) and the B.L.A.S.T. crew (junior and high schoolers) convening by 10:45 a.m as well. Watch for the announcements on when the Sunday School and small groups will start meeting face to face.

Did you know you have access to your individual account to update personal information, events, attendance and giving through the church database? You start by going to https://baldwinfumc.breezechms.com/login. to sign up with your name and passwordln addition to a safely distanced person welcoming you to Sunday worship, attendance will tsbe recorded by name (not just a headcount) into the church database by a designated person. Online giving can be done while you are in your account in the database or you can go to Baldwinfirst.org found under the giving tab.

Technology has played a big role in communicating and connecting each other this past year, trying to be there when we couldn't



be there. If you feel lost or overwhelmed with it all or worry about those who might not be getting the digital information, be assured mailings are still going being done to those who do not provide emails, and callers have volunteered to check in those who are homebound (and those folks never know when you are going to get a "goodie" bag delivered to your door!).
