Observing a Holy Lent

It was at the last of 3 Ash Wednesday services at the church where I served as an Associate. Our first had been at 6:30AM to catch folks on their way to work. The next at noon, for those who could slip away on their lunch hour. Now, at 6:30 pm, I was astounded to see that the large sanctuary was full. We got to the part of the service where we prepared to put ashes on the heads of the congregants who came forward, ready to mark their repentance.

First, my Senior Pastor and I would mark each other. As his thumb traced a cross on my forehead, I heard his voice say softly, "Remember your baptism, and give thanks." My Eyebrows went up a little, and he quickly added, "Remember you are dust, and to dust you shall return." We enjoyed a little smirk and then I marked his forehead with ashes too.

But his slip-up, the pastoral version of auto-pilot after 40+ years in ministry, unlocked for me a new connection with the practice. I remembered that the cross of Ashes on Wednesday is not unrelated to the mark of our baptism.

We repent, not because our baptism has failed, but because we believe in grace. We believe in the prevenient grace that leads us to faith before we even know we need it. We believe in justifying grace that is able to wipe clean even our foulest and most shameful sins, and in the repentance of Ash Wednesday and the practice of Lent, we confess our belief in Sanctifying Grace, the grace by which God renews, reforms, and reshapes us into the image of Christ.

There are many means of grace that can help us get in touch with God's sanctifying grace. Fasting is the most well known of these. There are many ways to engage in the practice of fasting. Some fast entirely on a certain day each week. Some fast from particular foods. Some may choose a non-food kind of fasting-social media fasts and fasting from online retail have become popular in recent years.

There are also practices of engagement that can be means of grace for a holy lent. Some choose to adopt a new prayer practice or rededicate themselves to a daily time of reading scripture. Some may choose to engage in a daily or weekly practice of service to others.

I encourage you to prayerfully consider how you will engage the means of grace this lent, so that you may make space for God's sanctifying grace to be at work in your life.
