Mid-September announces that summer is almost behind us and it is time to start changing our painting focus for the next season. Autumn, which is a favorite season of the year. Fall is a perfect time for all water media paintings. Why, you might ask. Let's look at two adjectives that are used with the autumnal season.

The first of these is the adjective "vivid". The meaning is bright-colored, brilliant, glowing strong, bold, flamboyant and eye-catching. The second is the word "kaleidoscopic" which means multicolored, many-hued, variegated, rainbow, or looking like an explosion of your paint supply. Both of these adjectives fit a watercolor palette like a glove.

Artwork Eligibility: Entries are limited to **one original painting** per artist. Paintings must be primarily watermedia. Collage may be used as long as watermedia is the dominant element. No computer-generated art, photography, prints or reproductions. Work must have been completed during the last three full years and not previously shown in a CCWS exhibit. Paintings done in a class or workshop are not eligible. Source material must be original and not derived from any published images.

Size limits: No size limits.

Digital submission of image:

- File format must be JPG.
- Image must be cropped to show only painting; no matting, background or frame allowed on image.
- Image must represent the painting exactly.
- Email image to: ccws@ccwsart.com
- Digital image due midnight October 15, 2022.

Online Entry Requirements:

Please CAREFULLY read the entire Prospectus before sending your entry. Your entry email with the jpeg of your painting will be your agreement to the terms and conditions set forth in this Prospectus. The jpeg image must be received by October 15 midnight, 2022. Once submitted, you will receive an email confirmation of receipt within 24 to 36 hours.

You will need to include the following information to in your email with your jpeg of your painting:

- Your name
- Title of your painting
- Medium watercolor, watermedia or collage
