Three-day workshop - Intuitive Painting with Watercolor & Gouache: Supply List

Paper: 6 half-sheets of 140 lb. Cold Press. or 300 lb. Cold Press watercolor paper (15 X 22 inches), or a 16 X16 inch 140 lb. cold press Fluid Watercolor Block, which is what I will be using (image below). I have found them online on Amazon.com or try Jerry's Artarama.



Transparent Watercolors of your choice.

Titanium white gouache (opaque watercolor).

- I only **use titanium white gouache** and mix it with watercolor, which makes the watercolor opaque. Read the label to make sure. In that sense I don't need colored gouache, but you are welcome to use colored gouache if you wish to do so.
- Please DO NOT bring <u>any</u> gouache or other paints that has acrylic in it (due to potential spilling and cleanup problems in the carpeted workshop space.)

Mixing trays, small paper plates or watercolor palette.

Watercolor brushes of your choice – various sizes

Acrylic style bristle brushes – various sizes (I use cheap 2" house painter brushes for much of my work).

Black Pilot Precise V5 Rolling Ball Ink Pen or water-soluble black ink pen of your choice

Spray bottle, water container, paper towels.

Isopropyl (rubbing) Alcohol.

Salt.

Optional:

- Gouache colors of your choice (be sure to have titanium white gouache)
- Black watercolor.
- Matte with an opening to fit the size of paper you will be working on.
- Wax crayons, birthday candles, paraffin sticks, etc., etc.
- Charcoal, graphite.
- Colored pencils.
- Scrapers (like a credit card, palette knife, etc.).
- Anything else you would like to use <u>except</u> acrylic paints, oil paints, or other media that pose cleanup problems if spilled).
