How To Register

- **Please note that all the registration requirements must be completed by September 24, 2021 to exhibit.**

Exhibiting Information and Requirements

- Since this is a fundraising event, **all art must be for sale.**
- Art subject matter must be appropriate for viewing by children.
- Entries accepted for exhibition must have a professional appearance: framed/matted if appropriate, paintings on canvas must have finished or painted edges. Artwork must be mounted with hanging wire approximately 1/3 down from top and must be able to hang from a single point. **Saw tooth hangers are not acceptable.**
- Entries must be your original creation. You may submit an archival print of your original work, priced accordingly.
- You will need to complete a "San Luis Obispo County Library Form" and return it to the Nipomo Library front desk for Nipomo Library Manager, Heidi LoCascio, or Assistant Michael Zepeda. The form is available at the Nipomo Library or you can download from the link on the email "Announcement" that Jerry sent to all the Monday Morning Painters.

Artwork Delivery and Pick-up Schedule

- Take-in/Set-up: Friday October 1, 2021 from 9:00 am to noon.
- Please have your name on the back of each of your pieces of art.
- Take down/Pick-up: Saturday October 30, 2021 from 10:00 am to noon.
- Show opens October 2 – closes October 29, 2021

Sales

- Twenty percent (20%) of sales will be donated to the Friends of the Nipomo Library (FONL) to support library and community programs.
- Checks for the 20% donation must be made out to the “***Friends of the Nipomo Library***,” and mailed to Phyllis Connolly, 1355 Vicki Lane, Nipomo CA, 93444 by **Friday November 5, 2021. You will receive a “Donation Statement” from the Treasurer of FONL.** Please be sure your address is on your check.
- Artists are asked to show and price pieces reasonably to encourage sales.
- The artist will be responsible for financial and delivery arrangements of the artwork with the buyer including any taxes related to the sale.
- The buyer may take the artwork at the time of sale and the artist may replace it with another piece of equal size. Please notify Phyllis Connolly of the sale. If there is no replacement art, Phyllis will arrange for a replacement.

Liability

The library will make every reasonable effort to protect your art, but neither the Library, its staff nor CCWS will be held responsible for any damage or theft of artwork. It is recommended that participants purchase their own insurance if desired.

Publicity and Marketing

News articles are planned for: the San Luis Obispo Library, *Friends of the Nipomo Library Newsletter*, The Central Coast Watercolor Society website, Monarch Radio, NextDoor, and FaceBook. Artists are also encouraged to market their work and promote the show.
