Juror of Selection and awards: Robert Burridge

Robert Burridge, a noted award-winning Industrial Designer who, after twenty-five years in the corporate world, focused his life to painting everyday. Burridge attributes his success to his education from the University of the Arts in Philadelphia, his stint as an adjunct professor at Cooper Union in New York City, and in 1966, his Fluxus art performances with Yoko Ono, Nam June Paik, Jim McWilliams and Charlotte Moorman.

His work hangs in permanent collections of international embassies, corporate galleries and art colleges. His solo museum exhibitions received positive attention, so he was invited to exhibit his paintings at the Smithsonian Folklife Circus Arts Festival in Washington, DC.

The 2020 Central Coast Watercolor Society Fall Members Only Juried Show will be held at the Art Center Morro Bay. All CCWS Members are encouraged to enter. All entries must conform to the details in this prospectus.

Purpose: The theme of this show is “**Outside the Box.**” Thinking outside the box is a metaphor that means to think differently, unconventionally, or from a new perspective. Outside the box simply means that you’re willing to consider a different solution and method for reaching your desired outcome. Approaching your art differently can have a powerful and positive effect on your work. It can present more possibilities and new creative methods that can help your work to continue to evolve.

Artists are asked to incorporate this theme in their submission. It may be to attempt a new subject, technique, material, or approach. The goal is to encourage you to experiment with something new to you! With your jpeg(s) submission, you will be asked to briefly

explain your “Outside the Box” description with your email text or as an attachment.

CCWS Membership: Membership forms are available from our website [CCWS Website Membership Page](#). and at our monthly meetings. General membership is \$30 paid annually.

June 23, 2020 - Midnight Digital Submission with your written description of “Outside the Box” and entry form are due.

July 1- Email notification and posting on CCWS website of accepted artists.

August 4- Receiving hand delivered paintings, 10:00 am to Noon, Art Center Morro Bay, 835 Main St. Morro Bay, CA.

August 9- Reception 2 pm to 3:00 pm.

September 14- Exhibition closes 4:00pm.

September 15- Pickup of paintings 10:00 am- Noon.

Awards: Cash and merchandise.

Artists' Eligibility: This show is only open to CCWS Members. Artists juried into the exhibition must exhibit the painting for the entire length of the show. Failure to exhibit after acceptance will result in ineligibility to enter any CCWS show or exhibition for the next two years.

Art Work Eligibility: Entries are limited to **two original paintings** per artist. Paintings must be primarily watermedia on natural or synthetic paper or paperboard, and unvarnished. No stretched canvas or clay-board. Collage may be used as long as watermedia is the dominant element. No computer-generated art, photography, prints or reproductions. Work must have been completed during the last three years and not previously shown in a CCWS exhibit. Paintings done in a class or workshop are not eligible. Source material must be original and not derived from any published images. All work must be for sale.

Size limits of Artwork Not Matted:

Minimum image size – 7 1/2” X 11” or 1/8th sheet.

Maximum image size - 15” X 22” or 1/2 sheet.

Matted and Framed:

Minimum Shortest Dimension – 13”

Maximum Longest Dimension - 28”.

Online Entries Only: Due Midnight June 23, 2020

Digital submission of image:

File format must be JPG, at least 300 dpi but not to exceed 8MB.

Image must be cropped to show only painting; no matting, background or frame allowed on image.

Each photo or file shall be named with the artist's Last Name, First name and title of the work only:

Example: Smith John My Cat (NO COMMAS)

Image(s) must represent the painting(s) exactly.

Digital image(s) and entry fee must be received or postmarked by Midnight – June 23, 2020.

Online Entry Requirements:

Go to [Entry Form MOS 2020](#) to create and complete your entry for 1 or 2 paintings. You will be asked to agree to the terms and conditions set forth in this MOS 2020 Prospectus.

Please read the entire Prospectus.

You will need the following information for each painting:

Title of painting (s)

Size of painting (s)

Selling Price (s)

Year Completed (2018, 2019, 2020)

Medium – watercolor, watermedia or collage

Entry, Image and fee must be received or post marked by June 23, 2020

A confirming email will be sent to you

Entry Fee and Instructions:

-Entry form and image(s) must be received by midnight, June 23, 2020.

-Entry fee for current CCWS members:

\$15 for one or two paintings.

-Fee must be paid by check or money order, payable to Central Coast Watercolor Society, or CCWS. No cash please. Entry fee of \$15 is non-refundable.

-Entry forms should be submitted online, following instructions, or can be printed and mailed along with your fee to:

Framing: Framing guidelines must be followed: --

Painting mats should be a minimum 2", white or neutral color. Colored liners are acceptable.

Glazing: Acrylic only.

Frame materials: Simple wood, metal or plastic, properly

reinforced. Heavy or ornate carved frames are not appropriate.

Diptychs and triptychs: These must be mounted within a single frame.

Frame size: Simple narrow gallery frames.

Hardware: Accepted work must be securely wired and ready to hang using D-rings. No saw-tooth hangers are allowed.

Method of Selection: The juror will make selections from digital images. **Only one entry per artist will be selected.** Artists will be notified of the juror's choice, and chosen entry must then be submitted for the exhibition. Final juror selection will be from the actual submitted work with the juror's right of refusal.

Liability and Conditions: Although the upmost care will be taken in handling paintings, CCWS and its representatives will not be responsible for damage or loss, whatever the cost. Artists should carry their own insurance. No work may be withdrawn before the end of the exhibit. The submission of entries to this competition shall constitute an agreement on the part of the artist to the terms and conditions as set forth in this prospectus.

Sales: All work must be for sale. A 30% commission will be retained by the Art Center Morro Bay. Please price your work accordingly. There will be no price changes after entry.
