Through an outpatient clinic, I provide comprehensive cognitive and neuropsychological evaluations and consultations to a wide range of toddlers, children, adolescents and young adults with neurological and rehabilitation conditions to establish neurocognitive and neurobehavioral profiles, generate recommendations for rehabilitation and medical treatment planning, and provide guidance to families to maximize functional participation and outcomes.
