### **Clinical Activity**

I successfully created, developed, and continue to direct the first pediatric clinical neuropsychology program at NYU Langone Health Brooklyn. Through an outpatient clinic, I provide comprehensive cognitive and neuropsychological evaluations and consultations to a wide range of toddlers, children, adolescents and young adults with neurological and rehabilitation conditions to establish neurocognitive and neurobehavioral profiles, generate recommendations for rehabilitation and medical treatment planning, and provide guidance to families to maximize functional participation and outcomes. I also provide inpatient consultation and assessment services to patients admitted to the pediatric unit for video

EEGs and pre-surgical planning. My primary focus is acquired/traumatic brain injuries and epilepsy, although I work with an extremely wide range of clinical diagnoses that impact cognitive, physical and functional abilities.

In my private practice, I provide clinical evaluations and consultation services to children, adolescents and adults with psychological, educational, neurodevelopmental and neurological/medical concerns. I also offer forensic evaluations and consultations to determine the severity and/or presence of neuropsychological impact due to neurological injury. This has included serving as an expert reviewer and consultant on pending litigation for both plaintiff and defendant counsel, as well as full independent medical evaluations (IME) and independent educational evaluations (IEE).

### **Education Activity**

I currently direct the pediatric clinical neuropsychology externship program at NYU Langone Brooklyn, which is part of the larger training program through the Department of Neurology's Division of Clinical Neuropsychology. This involves review of all externship applications, interviews, and participation in the official externship match through the Psychology Directors of NYS-New York New Jersey Association of Directors of Training (PSYDNYS-NYNJADOT). I provide full clinical and professional oversight to all externs in compliance with all APA and PSYDNYS-NYNJADOT training competencies, for a minimum of two full days per week. I give a minimum of five lectures and presentations per year through the Clinical Neuropsychology division's didactic series, rotate as a leader of the post-doctoral fellow journal club, and serve as an examiner for quarterly mock board certification exams.

I also serve as a supervisor to pre-doctoral interns through the American Psychological Association (APA)-accredited Rehabilitation Clinical Psychology Internship and post-doctoral fellows through the Pediatric Neuropsychology and Rehabilitation Fellowship at Rusk Rehabilitation.
