STANDARD TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Benefit Hub US Corporation (Benefit Hub)

1. Integration Clause:

This written Contract represents the entire event agreement between Vendor and Benefit Hub, and supersedes all prior negotiations, representations, contracts, or agreements, either oral or written for this event. There are not any additional representations, conditions, verbal agreements, written warranties, or implied warranties outside of this express written Contract. This Contract may only be amended or modified in writing signed by both Benefit Hub and Vendor.

2. Governing Law / Venue:

This Contract is governed by the laws of the State of Pennsylvania. Vendor and Benefit Hub agree to the venue of York County, Pennsylvania for any legal disputes.

3. Finance Charges:

A finance charge of 18% annual (1 1/2% monthly) will be applied to all Vendor past due balances over 15 days, with a minimum monthly late fee of \$25.00.

4. Insufficient Funds:

A \$50.00 re-processing fee will be charged for returned checks.

5. Collection:

Vendor agrees to pay all of Benefit Hub's collections costs and expenses, including legal and attorney fees, to enforce this Contract and collect amounts due from Vendor.

6. Currency:

Unless expressly stated otherwise, all currency and monetary amounts referred to in this Contract are in U.S. Dollars (USD).

7. Autonomy:

Benefit Hub is an independent company, and not an employee or agent of Vendor.

8. Indemnity:

Benefit Hub shall indemnify and hold harmless Vendor against any and all acts arising out of actions, omissions, or negligence by Benefit Hub or Benefit Hub employees. Vendor shall indemnify and hold harmless Benefit Hub against any and all acts NOT arising out of actions, omissions, or negligence by Benefit Hub or Benefit Hub employees.

9. Limitation of Liability:

Benefit Hub shall not be liable for any consequential damages nor any liquidated damages. Benefit Hub shall not be liable for any expectation damages beyond this event. Benefit Hub shall not be responsible for any personal injury claims, Vendor property or property insurance claims for damages, Vendor property loss, and/or Vendor property theft, including but not limited to actions arising out of strict liability, negligence, tort, or contract. Benefit Hub's liability is limited to this event. In no instance shall Benefit Hub be responsible for any claims above Benefit Hub's insurance coverage. Vendor shall be responsible for all Benefit Hub attorneys' fees and other expenses for all claims in which Benefit Hub is the prevailing party.

10. Assignment and Subcontracting:

Benefit Hub may assign or subcontract any portion of this Contract.

11. Enurement:

This Contract shall survive the parties and be binding to parties' successors and assigns but shall not have any personal liability on Benefit Hub shareholders or Benefit Hub employees.

12. Termination for Convenience:

Vendor may NOT terminate this Contract for convenience. Termination by Vendor for any reason will result in charges by Benefit Hub, up to and including the full value of the Contract.

13. Severability:

If any part of this Contract is deemed to be illegal, invalid, or unenforceable, the remainder of the Contract shall remain in full effect and be enforceable.

14. Waiver:

A waiver, breach, omission, or delay with regard to any part of this Contract on behalf of a party, shall not constitute a waiver by either party to any other provisions to this contract. All waivers shall be in writing.

15. Force Majeure:

Benefit Hub shall not be held liable for any failure, breach, or delay arising out a force majeure event. Force majeure events are events outside of the reasonable control of Benefit Hub including war, earthquakes, tornados, floods, severe storms, hurricanes, acts of God, fires, explosions, acts of government, acts of political parties, uprisings, insurrections, sabotage, terrorism, epidemics and/or embargoes.

16. Reparation:

Vendor shall grant Benefit Hub the opportunity to correct any issues, deficiencies, or breach of this Contract.

17. Titles:

All titles in this Contract are provided for convenience only and shall not change the meaning or interpretation of any text in this contract.
