On August 5th and 6th Tacoma Rifle and Revolver held the NW Regional match for the Sporter and Light Varmint classes. The results would be combined with the Heavy Varmint and 5 shot Unlimited NW Regional match results, previously held on June 2nd and 3rd, to determine the 2017 NW Regional Champion and the winner of the Del Bishop Award.

Sunrise on Saturday was deep red in color, and looked at first glance like a full moon. There were no clouds, but heavy smoke from recent forest fires made the whole sky seem overcast. The temperature was 62 degrees and a gentle head wind veered and backed as the morning progressed. By noon, Jim Stipe had shot the smallest group at .131", but Steve Kostanich won the morning agg with a .2150, besting Jeff

Lewis's .2364 agg.

By afternoon the temperature had risen to 80 degrees and there was plenty of mirage. The mostly left to right wind was moderate but still switching. Jeff shot both the smallest afternoon group at .227" and the best agg of .2666, toping Dan Kjelland's .2741 agg.

At the end of the first day Steve was in first place, winning the Sporter Class with a .2463 grand agg. Second place went to Jeff with a .2515.

Sunday began with 64 degrees and the same smoky haze as Saturday. The cross breeze was fairly mild with just a little mirage. Dan Kjelland shot the small group of .249" and also won the morning agg with a .2275. Steve was second with a .2464 agg.

By afternoon, the mirage had increased and the breeze had stiffened a bit. Jeff shot a screamer .057" to win the small group, but Steve won the agg

with an impressive .1924. Dan took second place with a .2530 agg.

At the end of the second day it was Steve who won the LV class with his .2194 grand agg, eclipsing Dan's .2403 second place finish.

Combining the weekend's Sporter and LV results put Steve on top again with a .2329 grand agg which again beat Dan's second place score of .2571.



It said "Long Range Shooting Perfection". I eagerly turned the handle and pushed open the door. Halfway across the large room I was surprised to see Ross Herrick standing there, he was talking with a guy with a long white beard and wearing flowing robes. Could that be Gandalf the Wizard?

I hurried toward them, hoping I too could find out some of the secrets of long range shooting to improve my scores and groups, but suddenly a uniformed secrurity guard stepped into my path, his outstretched hand stopped me in my tracks, looking at me sternly he said "Sir, YOU don't belong here"!

That's when I woke up.....

Near perfect weather in the southern Arizona desert turned out a large crowd of shooters at the Three Points Range, thirty miles west of Tucson. The top three shooters having all sub-MOA groups were Wild Bill Warner, who did an excellent job of shooting in relay three, he had an 8.12", a 7.25" and a 6.62" for a 7.33" aggregate, nicely done, but he was still third. Wayne McDonald was extremely consistent with three six inch groups, giving him a 6.41" agg. and a second place finish. But it was Ross Herrick who ended up in first place with a 5.66" aggregate and also posting the smallest group of 3.75". Way to go Ross! (seems like Deja Vu all

over again).

In Score Wayne McDonald had the highest single target of 49-3X, and a second place total of 137-3X, then again here comes Ross, working his magic, only dropping 8 points for a score of 142-1X to take first in overall score. The next six shooters all scored in the 130's. What a consistent bunch.

Heavy Gun groups were impressive as well. There were 14 groups below the 10.47" mark and the top five shooters all had sub-MOA aggregates. Lon Persun shot the smallest target with a very nice 5.93" group and ending up second with a 8.35" agg. However Ross Herrick was first, keeping all three of his groups in the small zone to shoot a 8.04" aggregate.



Jeff Locke was 3rd in HG AGG Score with 282-4X, and 2nd in HG AGG Group 3.473. Richard Jette was third in HG AGG Group with 3.663.

Our local gunsmith, Terry Wright, edged out Fred Dobson for 1st in LG AGG Score by a single point with a 145-5X. Terry has built many of the guns for our TCGC 600 yard Club shooters and does a masterful job with many world record

## **SAHUARO - JANUARY 2018**

Just walking down the line of shooting benches reveals a surprising variation of equipment. Actions, barrels, stocks, rests, scopes, etc. And this is only half of it, the other half is the equipment required to produce those loads and they are just as varied, but invisible since they are hidden away in the workshops, loading rooms and possibly laboratories at home. But it is just as important. You don't make loads that shoot the exceptional groups and scores at 1,000 yards that we see so often here at the Sahuaro Match without putting in a lot of meticulous work and having the right tools to get the job done.

It was another good turnout of expert long range riflemen with "Dead of Winter" temperatures of 45 degrees at sunup which warmed to a tolerable 72 degrees by noon. Winds stayed mostly light and co-operative through out the morning and early afternoon.

Light Gun got off to a good start with 16 sub-MOA groups shot, not only in relay one but in relay three also. The top four shooters in Light gun had sub-MOA aggregates, while the top three had all three of their groups well below the

10.47 inch mark. Topping the list was Ross Herrick who had the smallest Light Gun target of 4.43" along with his 5.56" and a 6.43" groups to win for Aggregate Group with a 5.48". Steve Everson was right behind him with a very respectable 6.96" agg and Pat Billotte was third with his 7.52"

In Score, out of the 33 groups shot, all but five of them scored in the 40's and the lowest one was 35. That's some good shooting! Steve Everson lead the way, only dropping 10 points with a 140-1X score. Dale Arenson was right behind him with a 137 and shot the highest single light gun target with a 5.68" 48 score. Ross Herrick was third with

Sometimes those "good" conditions worked against us. There were times when the flags hung limp and stayed there, giving us no choice but to do our best trying to shoot through the rising thermals as you could watch the "boil" show on the number boards. The groups in Heavy Gun showed that on paper, with out of 27 groups shot, only six of them were sub-MOA, and guess what, half of those belonged to Ross Herrick. He also shot the smallest Heavy Gun group with his 6.87"

and his 8.25" aggregate was the only sub-MOA agg that day, easily winning top honors.

Heavy Score had Dale Arenson taking first with his 277-3X and Ross Herrick on his heels with a 270-2X. Dale almost shot the highest single target with a 95-2X, but John Benz snuck in with a very nice 96-1X to win for the highest single target in heavy.

That wrapped up the first Sahuaro match of 2018 and once all of the flags and range equipment was put away, most of us dashed off to have lunch together in the small town of Three Points, Arizona. Time to get ready for the second Saturday of next month when we get to do it all over again. In the meantime, it is back to the laboratory or workshop as it may be, to try to improve those loads to the best of our ability. Then, all we have to do is shoot them well. Piece of cake....


