- **Mid-Week Connect:** 7:00 p.m. in the Young Adult Room. Come and join in the study of the Book of Proverbs.

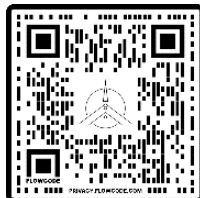
