All participants, both youth and adults, must register on the <u>CampRobertLCole.org</u> website **before** check-in.

Adults must complete the following before camp attendance (these requirements are monitored by wards and stakes and not checked at Camp check-in):

- Complete the LiveScan background check (for adults from California stakes)
- Finish the Church Youth Protection Training

All youth and adults need to bring <u>paper copies</u> of the following two documents to

the Camp Office at check-in. These papers will be maintained in a binder in the Camp Office and given back to participants when they leave Camp. Physical paper copies are needed as there is not always a connection to the internet at Camp Cole.

- □ Paper copy of `<u>Permission and Medical Release Form</u>'. Although each person agreed to this during online registration, we need paper documentation at camp for inspection or in case an individual needs medical assistance. Unlike years past, this **form does not need to be signed by a physician**.
- Paper copy of pre-camp lice check and health assessment (to be filled out within 24 hours before camp).
- ☐ If needed, checkbook for final fee Square up at Check-in.
