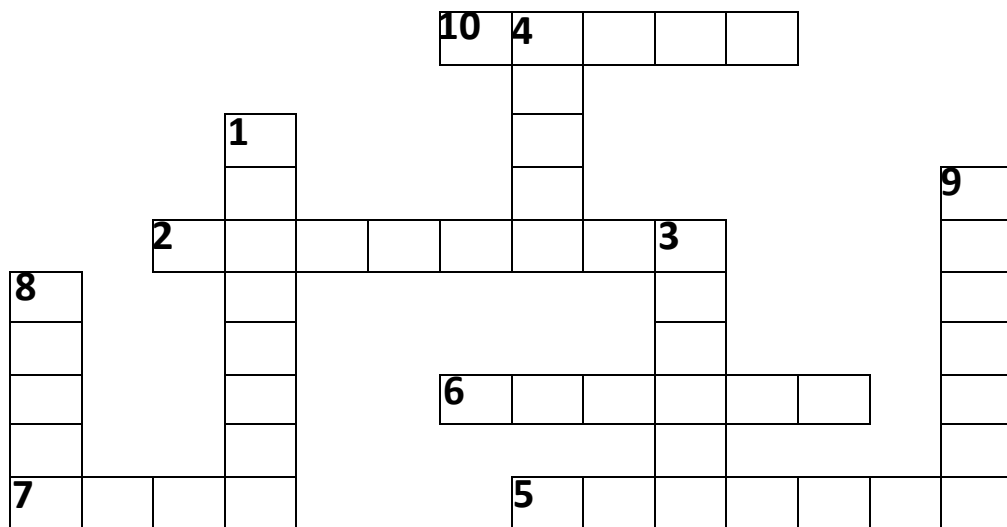


highlights from **ROMANS ... chapter 14**

- 1 DOWN: Be welcoming to those who are weak in the faith, but do not entertain disputes about D _ _ _ _ _ things. One person believes he may eat anything, while the weak person eats only vegetables. (Romans 14:1-2)
- 2 ACROSS: The one who eats anything should not despise the one who abstains from certain foods, and the one who abstains should not pass J _ _ _ _ _ on the one who eats, for God has welcomed him. Who made you the boss? it is to the Lord who is responsible for good or bad, that he stands or falls. And he will be upheld, for the Lord is able to make him stand. (Romans 14:3-4)
- 3 DOWN: One person considers one day more sacred than another; another considers every day alike. Each should be fully convinced in his own mind, doing so to the Lord. And in regards to eating meat or abstaining, do so to the Lord, giving T _ _ _ _ _ to God. (Romans 14:5-6)
- 4 DOWN: Remember, we neither live nor die for ourselves A _ _ _ _ . We live for the Lord and we die for the Lord. So, whether we live or die, we belong to the Lord. For to this end Christ died and rose again. (Romans 14:7-9)
- 5 ACROSS: Why pass judgment on or even D _ _ _ _ _ your brother? We will all stand before the judgment seat of God. So instead of continuing to judge one another, let us instead resolve never to put a stumbling block or hindrance in the way of a brother. (Romans 14:10-13)
- 6 ACROSS: I am persuaded in the Lord Jesus that nothing is unclean in itself, but it is unclean for anyone who T _ _ _ _ _ it unclean. So, if your brother becomes so upset by what you eat, is it worth continuing if it destroys a brother for whom Christ died? (Romans 14:14-15)
- 7 ACROSS: Your actions would not be from a place of love. Don't let something you consider good, end up being spoken about as E _ _ _ . (Romans 14:15-16)
- 8 DOWN: For the kingdom of God is not a matter of eating and drinking but of righteousness and P _ _ _ _ and joy in the Holy Spirit. So then let us pursue what makes for peace and for mutual upbuilding. (Romans 14:17-19)
- 9 DOWN: Do not, for the sake of food, destroy the work of God. Everything is indeed clean, but it is wrong for anyone to make another stumble by what he eats. It is good not to eat meat or drink wine or do anything that causes your brother to S _ _ _ _ . (Romans 14:20-21)
- 10 ACROSS: Keep the faith that you hold between yourself and God. Blessed is the one who has no reason to pass judgment on himself for what he approves. But whoever has doubts is condemned if he eats, because the eating is not from F _ _ _ _ . For whatever does not proceed from faith is sin. (Romans 14:22-23)
