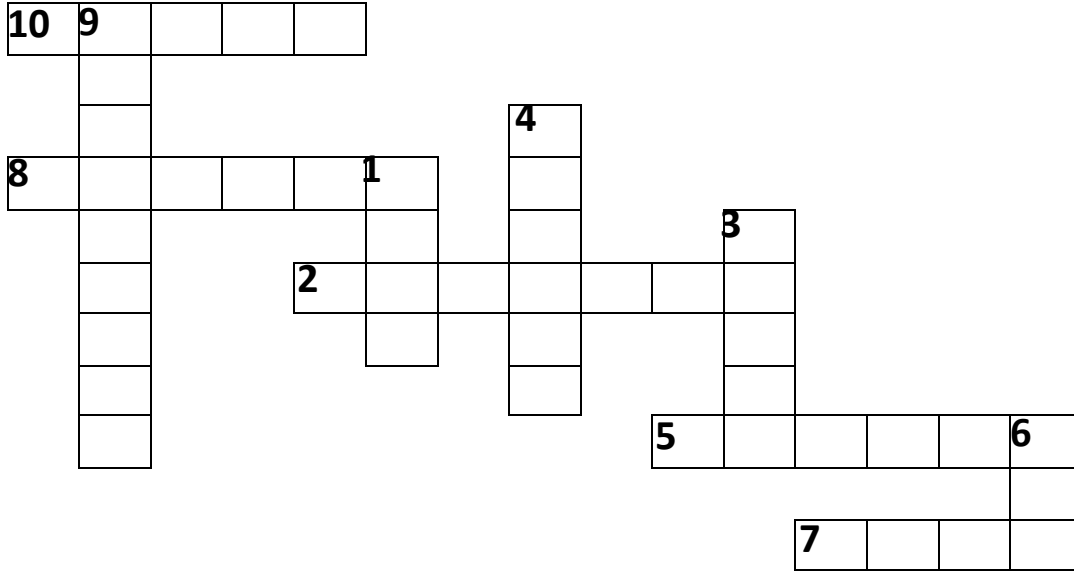


highlights from **EPHESIANS ... chapter 6**

- 1 DOWN: Children, obey your parents in the L __ __ __, for this is right. The first commandment with a promise is: "Honor your father and mother, that it may be well with you and you may live long on the earth." (Ephesians 6:1-3)
- 2 ACROSS: And you, fathers, do not P __ __ __ __ __ your children to anger, but bring them up in the training and discipline of the Lord. (Ephesians 6:4)
- 3 DOWN: Bondservants, obey your earthly masters with respect, fear, and with sincerity of heart; just as you would obey Christ. Obey them not only to win their favor when their eye is on you, but as slaves of Christ, doing the will of God from your H __ __ __ __. Serve wholeheartedly, as if you were serving the Lord, not people. (Ephesians 6:5-7)
- 4 DOWN: You know that the Lord will reward each one for whatever good you do, whether you are slave or free. So masters, apply these same principles to the way you treat your slaves. Do not threaten them, since you know that He who is both their Master and yours is in H __ __ __ __ __, and there is no favoritism with Him. (Ephesians 6:8-9)
- 5 ACROSS: Finally, my brethren, be S __ __ __ __ __ in the Lord and in his mighty power. Put on the whole armor of God, that you may be able to stand against the schemes of the devil. For our struggle is not against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the powers of this dark world and against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly realms. (Ephesians 6:10-12)
- 6 DOWN: Take up the entire armor of G __ __ __, so that having done all, you may be able to stand firm in the evil day. So stand, with the belt of truth buckled up; the breastplate of righteousness secured; ready to move with the shoes of the gospel of peace on your feet. (Ephesians 6:13-15)
- 7 ACROSS: Above all, take the shield of faith which will be enable you to extinguish all the fiery darts of the wicked one. And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the W __ __ __ of God. At all times praying in the Spirit; persevering, keeping alert, making prayers and supplications for all the saints. (Ephesians 6:16-18)
- 8 ACROSS: Also pray that whenever I speak, words may be given me so that I will fearlessly make known the mystery of the G __ __ __ __ __. Pray for me, for I am an ambassador for the gospel in chains; pray that I may speak boldly, just as I ought. (Ephesians 6:19-20)
- 9 DOWN: Tychicus, the dear brother and faithful servant in the Lord, will tell you everything, so that you also may know how I am, and what I am doing. I have sent him to you for this very purpose, that he may E __ __ __ __ __ __ __ __ your hearts. (Ephesians 6:21-22)
- 10 ACROSS: P __ __ __ __ be to the brothers and sisters; love with faith from God the Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (Ephesians 6:23)
