

*highlights from* **GALATIANS ... chapter 5**

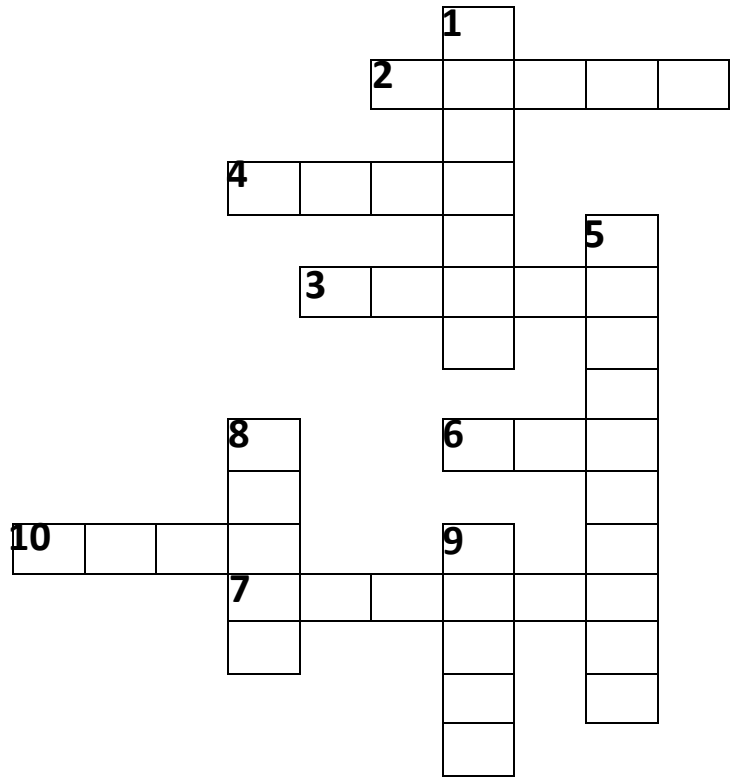
- 1 DOWN: Christ set us free, so be free; so stand firm in this F \_\_\_\_\_, and do not submit again to a yoke of slavery. Look: I, Paul, say to you that if you accept circumcision, Christ will be of no advantage to you. And I repeat: every man who lets himself be circumcised is obliged to obey the entire law. (Galatians 5:1-3)
- 2 ACROSS: In Christ neither circumcision nor uncircumcision is of value. All that counts is faith expressing itself through love. To be justified by law means falling from G \_\_\_\_\_; becoming estranged from Christ. Remember: it is by the Spirit that we eagerly await, by faith, the righteousness for which we hope. (Galatians 5:4-6)
- 3 ACROSS: I have confidence in you, in the Lord, that you will have no other way of thinking. The one who troubles you shall bear his judgment, whoever he is. Be careful of such for a little leaven leavens the W \_\_\_\_\_ lump. (Galatians 5:9-10)
- 4 ACROSS: You were running a good R \_\_\_\_\_. Who cut in on you to keep you from obeying the truth? That kind of persuasion does not come from the One who calls you. (Galatians 5:7-8)
- 5 DOWN: Brethren, if I still preached circumcision, the preaching of the cross would no longer offend some. Answer me this: Would I still be P \_\_\_\_\_? I wish that those who trouble you by insisting on circumcision would even cut themselves off! (Galatians 5:11-12)
- 6 ACROSS: Now the entire law is fulfilled in keeping this one command: "Love your neighbor as yourself." Serve O \_\_\_\_\_ another humbly in love, not using the freedom to which you were called to indulge the flesh. If you bite and devour each other, watch out or you will be destroyed by each other. (Galatians 5:13-15)
- 7 ACROSS: I say then: Walk in the S \_\_\_\_\_, and you shall not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh. They are in conflict with each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. So if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. (Galatians 5:16-18)
- 8 DOWN: The works of the F \_\_\_\_\_ are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions, and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, as I did before, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God. (Galatians 5:19-21)
- 9 DOWN: But the F \_\_\_\_\_ of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. (Galatians 5:22-24)
- 10 ACROSS: So if we L \_\_\_\_\_ by the Spirit, let us also keep in step with the Spirit. And let us not become conceited, provoking one another, and envying one another. (Galatians 5:25-26)
