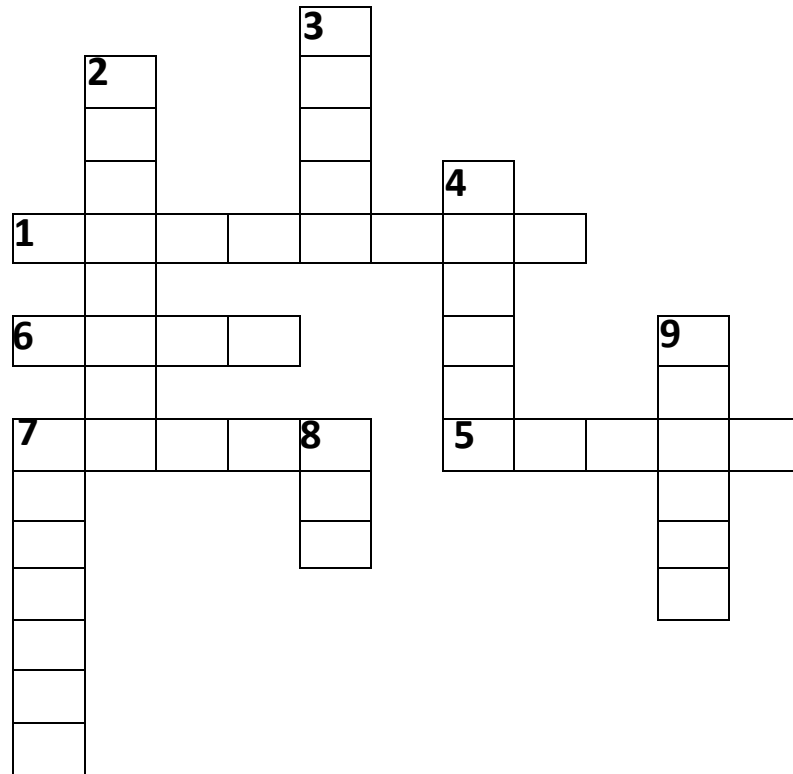
the Good News

highlights from **ROMANS ... chapter 10**

- 1 ACROSS: B _ _ _ _ _ and sisters, my heart's desire and prayer to God for Israel is that they may be saved. I am sure of their zeal for God but it is not a zeal based on knowledge. (Romans 10:1-2)
- 2 DOWN: They are trying to establish righteousness on their own terms instead of submitting to God's terms. For Christ is the end of the law for righteousness to E _ _ _ _ _ who believes. (Romans 10:3-4)
- 3 DOWN: For Moses writes this about the righteousness that is by the law, "The person who does those things will live by them." But the righteousness based on F _ _ _ _ _ says, "Don't ponder in your heart about who will go up to heaven to bring Christ down; or who will go down to bring Christ up from the dead?". (Romans 10:5-7)
- 4 DOWN: instead, it says, "the Word of faith (which we P _ _ _ _ _) is right here, it's in your mouth and heart and if you use your mouth to declare that Jesus is Lord and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead you will be saved." (Romans 10:8-9)
- 5 ACROSS: Because it is with the H _ _ _ _ _ that one believes and is justified, and it is with the mouth one professes and is saved. For the Scripture says, "Whoever believes on Him will not be put to shame". (Romans 10:10-11)
- 6 ACROSS: For everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. It doesn't matter if they are Jew or non-Jew, for the same Lord is L _ _ _ _ _ of all, bestowing His riches on all who call on Him. (Romans 10:12-13)
- 7 ACROSS: And why would they call on Him if they don't believe? And how are they to believe in Him if they have not H _ _ _ _ _ about Him; And how can they hear if there is no preacher? And how are they to preach unless they are sent. For it is written, "How beautiful are the feet of those who preach the good news!" (Romans 10:14-15)
- 7 DOWN: Yes! faith comes by H _ _ _ _ _ , that is hearing through the Word of God. But not all who heard have obeyed the gospel. Isaiah asks, "Lord, who has believed what he has heard from us?" But I ask, "Have they not heard?" Indeed yes. (Romans 10:16-18)
- 8 DOWN: So, I then ask, "Did I _ _ _ _ _ not understand?" Moses answers first saying, "I will make you jealous of those who are not a nation, with a foolish nation I will make you angry." And Isaiah boldly says "I have been found by those who did not seek Me; I have shown Myself to those who did not ask for Me." (Romans 10:19-20)
- 10 ACROSS: But of Israel he says, "All D _ _ _ long I have held out my hands to a disobedient and contrary people." (Romans 10:21)
