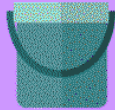


FULL Board

PART Board



The barn staff feeds and waters your horse on a regular schedule.



You are responsible for feeding and watering your horse.



The barn staff cleans your horse's stall and/or paddock every day. They provide bedding and change it regularly.



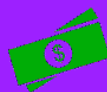
You are responsible for cleaning your horse's stall and/or paddock and changing the bedding. You probably have to provide your own bedding.



The barn staff is responsible for turning your horse out and bring them back in if turnout is available.



If turnout is available, you are responsible for turning your horse out and bringing them back in.



There are often extra services for a fee, including blanketing, fly spraying, feeding supplements, and holding for the vet.



Extras can include caring for your horse while you're on vacation as well as any extras offered for full board clients.



More uncommon amenities include grooming, bathing, exercising, and trailer parking.



Most boarding facilities allow equal access to arenas, trails, and tack room space. However, some put restrictions on facility usage for part board clients.
