



In first year, I was a member of both the concert and jazz bands playing electric bass.


During my second year I overloaded my courses and still maintained everything I mentioned above.


Campaign Experience

Additional Information

I wrote my first musical piece (a piano solo) around 8 years old. By the age of 11 I had lifted most of the Ocarina of Time and Majora's Mask soundtracks so that I could understand how Koji Kondo was able to be so emotionally effective in his composition. Since then I have amassed a sizable library of soundtracks totaling hundreds of hours of music that I study weekly for insights. Furthermore, I often find myself stopping what I am doing in a game and studying how the composer's work is affecting the scene or listening to soundtracks to get ideas for different compositional techniques. I was inspired to become a video game composer when I found myself sitting on the title screen of Xenoblade Chronicles (Wii) listening to Yoko Shimomura's masterpiece for 2 hours straight. At that point I realized that I wanted to have that powerful of an effect on someone else as well.
