Program Goals and Objectives:

To remove barrier to K9 service dog training to veterans and active duty service members.

2. To create a standard of operations for training K9 Service dogs .

3. To bring together K9 Trainers to review, adjust standards and develop and establish an agreed upon set of standards for training Service dogs, specifically for veterans and active duty related health issues.

Highlighting our current set challenges and solutions

- As of January 2022, the most current rate of veteran suicide in the United States was approximately 17.2 deaths by suicide per day, according to data from the Department of Veterans Affairs (VA). $17.2 \times 365 = 6278$ Veterans a year
- Currently there are no standard operating procedures, manual or a cohesive set of guidelines for training service dogs tailored to veterans within the United States.
- Because there is no current SOP, there are no accredited trainers adhering to a standardized framework tailored explicitly for the veterans' service dog training sector.

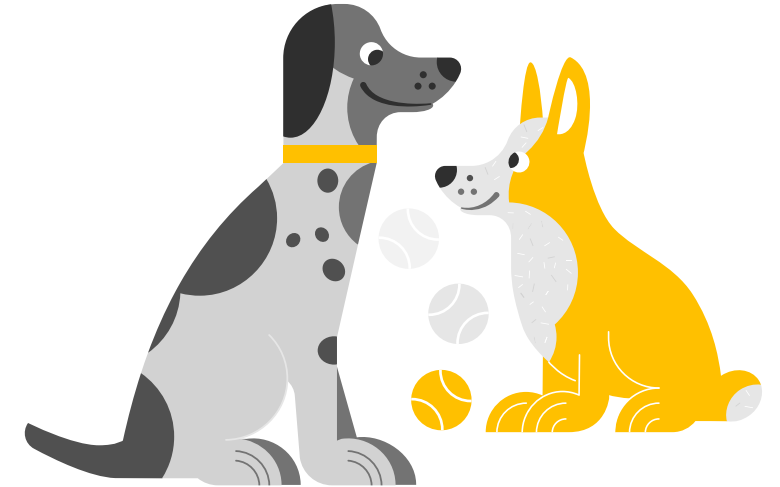
Ensuring trainers are equipped to train service dogs

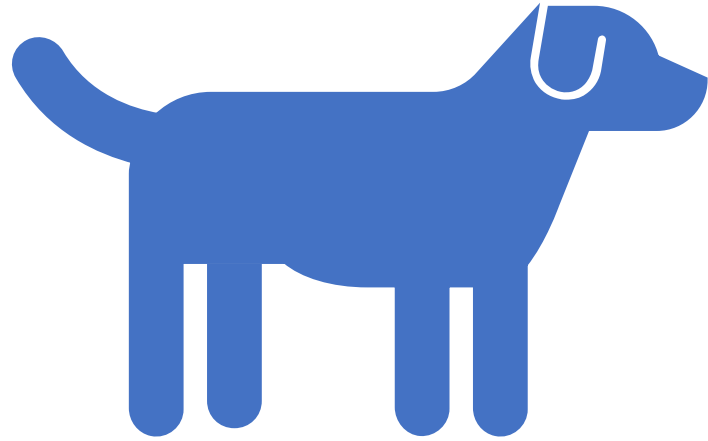
Connecting Veterans with Service Dogs
