Pastor Sheppard retired from forty-three years of pastoral ministry, having also served congregations in East Palo Alto, California, and Kansas City Missouri. In addition to his pastorates, Pastor Sheppard also spent three years as a full-time revivalist.

Pastor Sheppard has served extensively as a revivalist, conference leader and convention speaker both nationally and abroad. He is a graduate of Mid America Nazarene University and is the recipient of an Honorary Doctor of Divinity degree from the Southern California School of Ministry. Dr. Sheppard's vision is to use his ministry and pastoral experience to support and serve the body of Christ.

He and his wife, Linda, have been married for forty-eight years and are the proud parents of three sons and one daughter and the delighted grandparents of twelve grandchildren and two great grandchildren.
