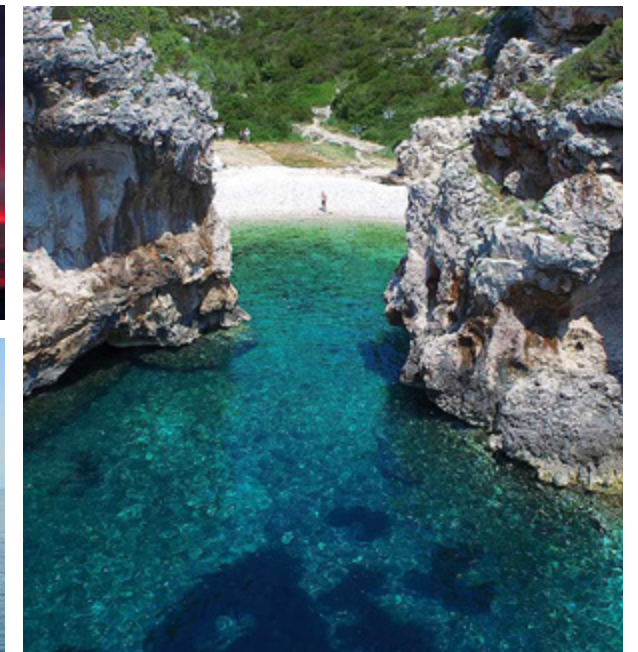

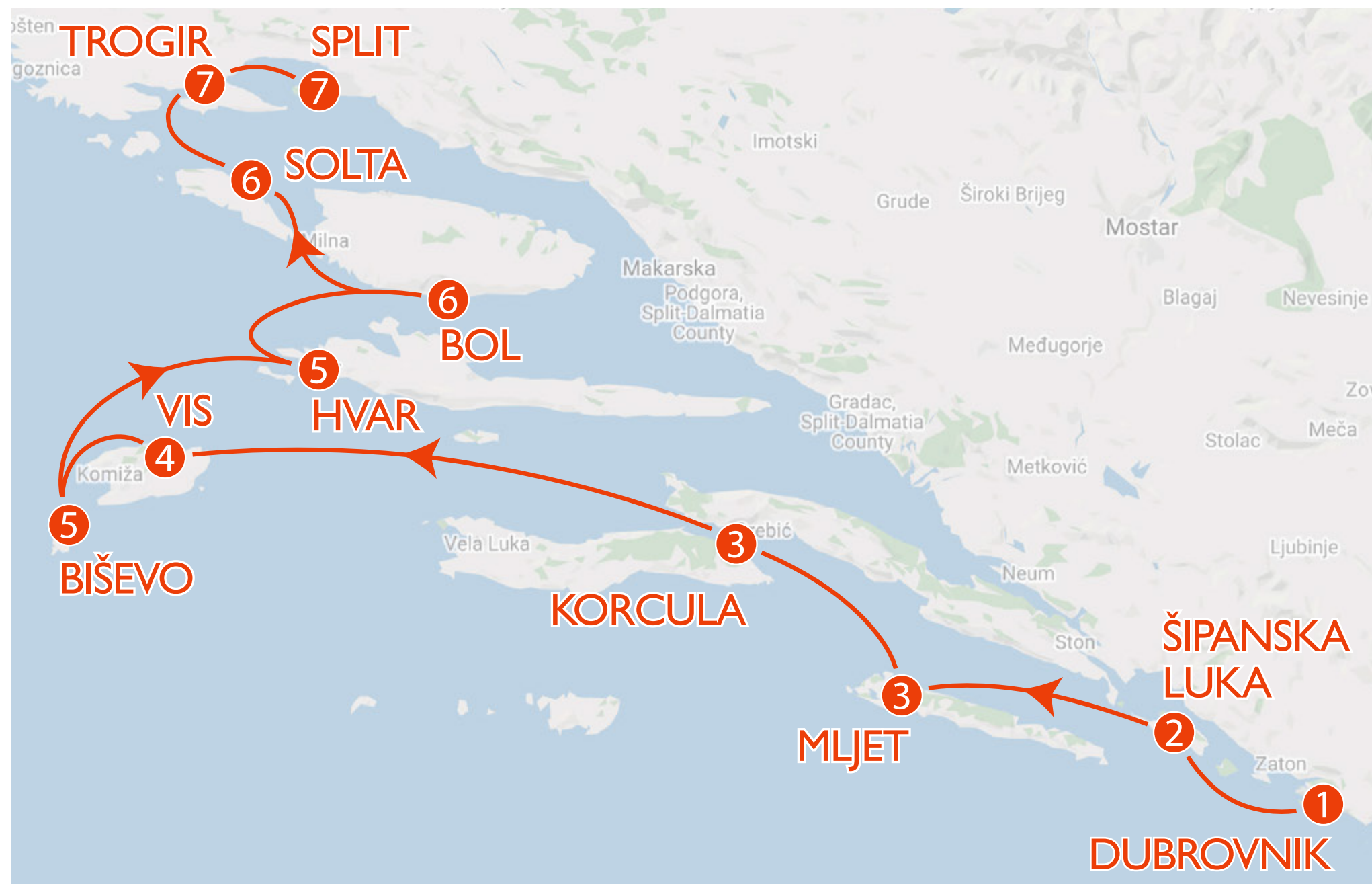
WHY CROATIA?

DUBROVNIK

DAY I

ACTIVITIES:

- Welcome drink and introduction to your captain and crew
- Personal guided tour of historical city center of Dubrovnik, a World Heritage site
- Complementary kickoff dinner with fellow passengers
- Hot tub, star gaze, or dance party in Old Town...choose your own nightly adventure




ŠIPANSKA LUKA

DAY 2

ACTIVITIES:

- Morning cruise by the magnificent shores of the Elaphiti archipelago, featuring the beaches and pristine scenery of the three main islands Šipan, Lopud, and Koločep
- Overnight anchorage for a relaxing evening in Šipanska Luka, one of Elaphiti Islands' small picturesque, peaceful fishermen's villages

MLJET

DAY 3

ACTIVITIES:

- Enjoy Mljet National Park and explore the island with hiking trails, bike paths, canoeing waterways, and a boat to Islet of St. Mary, with its 12th century monastery
- Swim in the park's two saltwater lakes – Veliko and Malo Jezero
- Midday swim on way to Korcula, thought to be the birthplace of Marco Polo



KORCULA

DAY 3

ACTIVITIES:

- Guided tour of Korcula Town, known as “Little Dubrovnik” because of its medieval squares, churches, palaces, and houses
- Have pre-dinner cocktails in an original medieval tower along the city's walls
- Treat yourself to the many fine dining restaurants that Korcula has to offer




VIS

DAY 4

ACTIVITIES:

- Visit Vis, a town left untouched by the development of tourism—the island contains beautiful beaches, preserved nature, ecological agriculture, and traditional architecture
- Choice of moped ride, military tour, or speedboat to Green Cave and Stiniva Beach
- Enjoy a commanding sunset view from former British naval fortification built in 1813



BIŠEVO

DAY 5

ACTIVITIES:

- VIP experience of the Blue Cave of Island Biševo—sunlight through the water reflects from the limestone floor of the cave, bathing the grotto in brilliant blue light
- Extended swim stop within the Pakleni Islands of Hvar, with the possibility of jet skiing, or a speedboat ride to nearby secluded beaches and coves



HVAR

DAY 5

ACTIVITIES:

- Curated walking tour of Hvar's rich history, culture, and way of life
- Explore Hvar, a popular tourist destination and considered to be Europe's sunniest island
- Ascend a winding path to the Spanish Fortress for a breathtaking sunset view of the harbor
- Dine in one of the city's numerous family-owned restaurants



BOL—SOLTA

DAY 6

ACTIVITIES:

- Morning sail toward Brač Island, known for its quarry of brilliant white limestone
- Visit Bol and explore one of the Adriatic's most famous seaside resorts
- Take a dip at Croatia's best-known beach, Zlatni Rat—a uniquely shaped white pebble beach
- Overnight anchorage for Captain's Dinner in secluded cove on Island of Solta



TROGIR

DAY 7

ACTIVITIES:

- Lunch and a swim en route to Trogir, which is on the UNESCO's World Heritage List
- Trogir remains an excellent example of a medieval town, conserving its original historic Roman city layout of orthogonal streets with minimal modern interventions
- Climb the bell tower of St Lawrence's Cathedral for a panoramic view of this quaint town



SPLIT

DAY 7

ACTIVITIES:

- Personal guided tour of Split's historical Diocletian's Palace, a World Heritage Site
- Stroll along the Riva, a seafront promenade full of cafes and bars, or hike the highest point in Park Suma Marjan to take in the expansive and magnificent view from Vrh Telegrin
- Spend the evening exploring the nightlife of Split's Old Town



SPLIT

DAY 8

ACTIVITIES:

- Wake up one last time on the beautiful blue waters of Croatia, in the unofficial capital of Dalmatia and the largest city on the Croatian coast
- One final group breakfast on board
- Hugs and kisses all around, as you depart for home...or on to your next adventure

CABIN PRICING

Cabins are either on the Main or Lower Deck:

- Lower Deck Standard Cabins (6) — with portholes
- Lower Deck Triple Cabins (2) — with portholes, up to 3 guests
- Main Deck Standard Cabins (9) — with windows
- Main Deck Premium Cabin (1) — with windows, largest on ship, bathroom vanity has 2 sinks

Deck selection based on availability. First come, first reserved.

Cabins are configured with either a queen or twin bed arrangement. All rooms are air-conditioned with an ensuite luxury bathroom.
