Beverage Policy

Performers/Artist and their staff are prohibited from consuming alcoholic beverages prior to their performance.

Items Liability

Items brought on site are done so at the sole risk of the performer/artist. IAHF is not responsible for any loss, damage or destruction of personal property, equipment and or valuables.

Behavior of Performers/Artists

Any Behavior by Performer's/Artist's family members or employees that is disruptive, abusive, or threatening towards other members, the public, or staff members is prohibited. Behavior that is verbally or physically abusive, dangerous, or disruptive to event activities will also not be tolerated and may result in IAHF / event Chairs asking for you to leave.

- Performers/Artists will be held responsible for all damage incurred by them, their staff, or their vehicles to the town of Fountain Inn.
- Foul or offensive language will not be tolerated at the event.
- No open alcoholic beverages or firearms may be brought on to designated festival areas. Performers/Artists and their associates are not to be intoxicated on site.
- Performers/Artists may not sell or offer any products or literature deemed offensive or which may incite violence, crime, disorderly conduct or promote political or religious viewpoints.
- Performers/Artists are responsible for their children and guests at all times.
- Except for service animals, pets are prohibited at this event unless included in Performers/Artist routines.

Cancellations

Any Performer/Artist wishing to withdraw from the event must notify IAHF by email by March 31, 2025, that they are unable to participate in the event.

Sound/ Stage Layout/Equipment:

All performers must provide their sound needs, specific stage layout, or other equipment upon execution of this agreement.
