To Whom It May Concern:

I am writing on behalf of the WHSRA to inform you that we are accepting bids for the state finals for the 2023-24 State HS Finals. The 2023 & 2024 finals will be held in Rock Springs. The scheduled dates are June 5th-11th, 2023 and June 3rd-9th, 2024.

Written bids should be sent to the WHSRA State Secretary, Shelly Thompson and should be received no later than June 8th 2022. The Wyoming State High School rodeo board will be meeting on Wednesday June 8th to make the final decision. You are welcome to attend this meeting and present your bid in person and answer any questions.

Bids will not be made public and members will not have access to review those bids until that date. When submitting a bid you have the option of submitting just a rough stock bid or just a timed event bid or for all stock for the state finals. The WHSRA reserves the right to refuse any bid. The successful bid may have additional livestock conditioning requirements. The WHSRA livestock committee will have the right to approve any and all stock included in any bid.

A Rough stock bid shall include the following, all of High School quality competition:
(The WHSRA prefers a per out fee for stock and flat fee for pick-up men & bullfighters; contractor provides all help for loading and WHSRA will provide stripping chute help)

- Bareback Horses
- Saddle Bronc Horses
- Bulls
- 2 Pick-up men
- 2 Bullfighters

A timed event bid shall include *(per run fee; WHSRA will provide loading and stripping help)*:

- Breakaway calves
- Tie Down Calves
- Team Roping Cattle
- Steer Wrestling Steers
- Goats (optional-as we do have accept goat only bids)

The number of usable stock for each event is clearly defined in the NHSRA rule book. Please refer to the attached page that will list exact stock numbers from previous state finals and the number of contestants per event for the 2021-2022 season through Casper. There can be up to 5 extras for each timed event, not more than that. For the 2022 we have scheduled all events (rough stock and timed events) in evening performances, with timed events only (no SW) in slack during the morning. This may change for 2022 based on current numbers and what the board seems to be the best fit.

Hay will be provided for the stock from Wednesday at noon until Sunday morning. It will be the stock contractor's responsibility to feed and water the stock. It is also the stock contractor's responsibility to doctor and care for any sick or injured animals. Stock can be checked in to the facility on Wednesday and will need to be removed from the facility by Sunday morning. There are additional requirements for stock, i.e. size, weight, gender, horns, etc. in the National HSRA rule book. Offering a bid for stock at the

Wyoming High School finals is an acceptance of the NHSRA rules. If you have any questions, please refer to the NHSRA rule book.

Pens will be provided for the pickup men's horses. All bids must include any housing needs for the contractor's personnel.
