- Initial payment of 20% of the trip total (\$100 nonrefundable deposit and \$25 registration fee included) is accepted for all overnight trips is due on the date indicated in the travel contract. All travelers must pay the registration fee.

90 days before departure (or as stated on travel contract) All applications are due with \$125 deposit/registration fee.

75 days before departure (or as stated on travel contract)

All applications here and after are considered late applications. A late fee of \$75 must accompany the application along with the \$125 initial payment. Final payments should be in by this date. (All late applicants are on a waiting list for bus and flight availability.)

60 days before departure (or as stated on travel contract)

Applications received here and after should be accompanied by full payment. We cannot mail partial reservations. Every account not paid in full by this date may be removed from the trip (without warning). If there is no availability for flight or transportation, we will provide "land-only" arrangements at your request. This means that you must provide your own arrangements for transportation to meet your group.


Personal checks, cashier's checks, money orders, Visa, and MasterCard accepted for payment. Returned checks will be charged \$30.

More than 65 days before departure

64–21 days before departure

60% refund minus the \$25 registration fee and the \$100 nonrefundable deposit. If a replacement is registered prior to the refund request, the deposit is refunded also.
