

McHenry County Local Transportation Guide

Dial-a-Rides

McHenry Township Senior Express Bus:

- Service Area: McHenry Township
- Eligibility: McHenry Township residents aged 60 or over or a person with a disability
- Service Hours: Monday through Friday: 7:30 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.
- Fare: \$1 per ride, \$2 round trip
 - Can purchase 12 vouchers for \$10
- Registration: Call (815) 385-5605 for more information
- Reservations: Call (815) 385-5605
 - Reservations can be made 24 hours in advance or up to 14 days in advance.

Algonquin Township Shuttle:

• Service Area: Algonquin Township

- Eligibility: Algonquin Township residents aged 55 or over or a person with a disability
- Service Hours: Monday through Friday: 7 a.m. to 3 p.m.

• Fare: \$3 one-way

- Registration: Call (847) 639-2700 ext. 6 for more information.
- Reservations: Call (847) 639-2700 ext. 6
 - o 24 hours in advance or up to 7 days in advance.
 - Medical appointments can be reserved 30 days in advance.

Senior Bus Ride Program:

- **Service Area:** Richmond and Burton Townships up to a 20-mile radius from Richmond Township Office
- **Eligibility:** Richmond and Burton Township residents aged 50 or over or a person with a disability
- Service Hours: Monday through Friday: 8 a.m. to 2:30 p.m.
- Fare: Services will not be denied based on inability to pay.
 - o Richmond, Spring Grove, Genoa City, WI: \$3 fare
 - o Johnsburg, Wonder Lake: \$4 fare
 - o Antioch, Fox Lake, Hebron, McHenry, Twin Lakes, WI: \$5 fare
 - o Woodstock, Burlington, WI, Crystal Lake, Lake Geneva, WI: \$6 fare
- **Registration:** Call (815) 678-0077 for more information.
- Reservations: Call (815) 678-0077



Reservations can be made 24 hours in advance.

MCRide:

- **Service Area:** McHenry County including 7 expanded point destinations: Advocate Good Shepherd Hospital, Barrington Metra Station, Randall Oaks Park/Zoo/Golf Course, The Arboretum, Advocate Sherman Hospital, Spring Hill Mall, and Chain O'Lakes State Park
- Eligibility: Open to the general public
- Service Hours: Monday through Sunday: 5 a.m. to 11 p.m.
- Fare:
 - For the general public: \$4 for the first 5 miles and \$0.25 for each additional mile
 - Older adults 60 or over and persons with a disability: \$2 for the first 5 miles and \$0.25 for each additional mile
- Registration: No registration required
- Reservation: Call (800) 451-4599 to reserve a ride
 - Older adults and persons with a disability may schedule a ride 7 days in advance.
 - The general public may schedule a ride 2 days in advance.

Volunteer Transportation Programs

Senior Services Associates Volunteer Transportation Program:

- Service Area: McHenry County for needs-based services
- Eligibility: McHenry County residents aged 60 or over
- Service Hours: flexible hours
- Fare: free
- Registration: Call (815) 344-3555 for more information.
- Reservation: Call (815) 344-3555
 - Reservations must be made seven days in advance.

Senior Care Volunteer Network:

- **Service Area:** McHenry County
- **Eligibility:** McHenry County residents aged 60 or over; must be able to get into a vehicle without assistance
- **Service Hours:** Monday through Sunday: 6 a.m. to 7 p.m.
 - o Service is not guaranteed because it is volunteer based.
- Fare: Free but donations are appreciated
- **Registration:** Call (815) 455-3120 for more information.
- Reservation: Call (815) 455-3120



Reservations must be made three days in advance.

Subsidized Taxi Programs

MCRide Connect:

- Service Area: Ride must begin or end with McHenry County
- Eligibility: Must be a McHenry County Resident, have a valid RTA Reduced Fare, Ride Free, Access, or ADA Paratransit Card, and have an account with Uber or UZURV with a valid credit card attached
- **Service Hours:** Hours determined by rideshare company
- Fare: \$4 up to a \$20 trip, rider is responsible for paying any portion that exceeds \$20, any surcharges, and any driver tip.
- **Registration**: Enrollment must be completed online at www.mchenrycountyil.gov/departments/transportation/mcride-connect
