The stream is made of yards of sheer water-colored fabric, enough to stretch across the entire length of the stage.

Music

Inspired by Beethoven, for keyboard and occasional drum and flute.

1. The Kalevala Melody

Introduction by the Dramaturg

Before our story begins we'd like to acknowledge our debt to the Kalevala, the epic poem and creation story of Finland. The music you just heard is called the Kalevala Melody. The Kalevala is not a unified narrative, rather it is a collection of wonderfully poetic folk stories about Finland, fen land, the land of water.

Why should we care about the Kalevala, you might ask. It's just a myth.

A myth is a story from our collective imagination that reveals our deepest hopes, desires and fears. Every myth is symbolic. Stories are passed down through generations, yet they change to incorporate new challenges. You may blunder into a myth when you least expect it.

2. Water Music in Five

Scene 1

Three café tables are spread across the stage with two or three chairs at each. The Dramaturg welcomes the audience, tells them the play opens in a coffee shop and volunteers are needed to sit at the tables as customers. The Dramaturg selects five or six people including Father and child (seated in the audience) to sit at the tables and instructs them to talk to each other about something that happened during their day. Father and child have a single, brief exchange. Then he looks at his phone and child is absorbed in her book. The waitress begins to deliver their orders and engages in small talk at the tables. She arrives at Father's table last.

Waitress (delivering drinks)

Let's see, I've got a double latte frappuchino here (sets it in front of child, child ignores it and continues to read) and a water no ice (Places it in front of Father) That all you're having?

Father

All? Water is everything.

Waitress

Sure, yeah. Like sixty percent of your body, right?

Father

Like seventy-one percent of the surface of the earth. Have you ever really thought about water?

Waitress

Well, yeah. We use a lot of water here.

Father

Where does it come from? Where does it go?

Waitress

I guess it gets recycled.

Father

Water has been recycling itself since the very beginning.

Waitress (laughing)

You're drinking recycled dinosaur pee.

Child (looks up, interested)
Ewww!

Father

Yes, well, they say that water has memory. I'm not sure I believe it, but this kiddo and I, we're planning to follow a drop of water from ______ (name a local river) all the way to Lake Michigan, through the Great Lakes to the St. Lawrence Seaway.

Child

Maybe even to the Atlantic.

Waitress

For real?

Child

Yeah. We're kayakers. But if we had a Viking Ship we could cross the Atlantic.

Waitress

Crossing the Atlantic in a Viking ship? Sounds horrible! You'd freeze. It would take forever and you might drown. Why would you want to do that?

Father

She's on this kick to—

Child

Dad! It's not a kick. It's my quest. (Flute plays Quest theme.)

Father

Excuse me. Ever since she found some old book she's been on a *quest* to go to Finland.

Child

Dad! I told you!. Don't call it an old book! It's the Kalevala. *(flourishes the book)* "The maiden of the air descends into the sea. There she is seduced—"

Dragonfly enters and flies about.

Waitress

Damn fly! (She chases with flyswatter.)

Child

Whoa! It's a *dragonfly!* (She chases.)

Waitress knocks over Father's water. Sound of rushing water is heard. Lights go to intense blue. Dramaturg comes and advises all the customers to leave the coffee shop. All exit. Water (fabric) streams across the stage. Music. Lights fade to black. The tables and chairs are removed.

Water (spoken in darkness, Water Music in 5 Reprise underneath)

Desire.

A surge

A mighty inward urge readies me for singing. Comes now the beginning.

Molecular desire and vital incantation chemical attraction the story of creation.

simple and elegant Water Mother future of all living elements.

Lights up.

5. Maiden of the Air

Water

The maiden of the Air descends *(stream rises)* into the Sea, there she's seduced by the Wind and Air. I am the Mother of Water.

Sini

A Dragonfly descending T'ward the Water Mother Comes a-flying hither-thither. Where to safely make her nest?

Flies she eastward, flies she westward,
Water and Sini
Circles northward, circles southward,
Where to safely make her nest?

Water

The Dragonfly builds her nest upon my knee, and lays her eggs. (stream recedes. Little dragonfly is born.) They hatch and form the earth,

Water and Sini

sky, sun, and moon and clouds.

Short Dance

Sini

All is well with the elements. Frolicking, fluttering in their orbits. Flitting, fluting through the seasons

All

Peaceful times can never last. Peaceful times can never last.

Water

Warmer grows the water round me
Hotter still my ocean bed
Oh! My backbone has been kindled
And my belly also burning
Fire in every vein is coursing ... (screams)

Sini

Water gave birth to a son!

All

Nixie! Nixie! Nixie!

Sini

Hail to thee O son of Water. Who are you? What will you do?

Water

Now at last my life is full.

Together we will chart vast kingdoms, frolic in them, we will sing!
then
he will listen to my stories.

Our legends will live on in glory!
Nixie will become a minstrel.

Sini

Singing to the fish!

Water

God, grant me just one wish: May Nixie live with me forever.

Sini

What did you say?
That sounds like trouble!
Sons must leave their mothers.

Water

No!

(little Nixie comes in swimming wrapped in water-gauze)

Sini

Nixie is a curious boy-o and his questions do annoy her.

Nixie

Mother, tell me, who's my father?
Is he somewhere?
Not in water?

Water

Such a silly question, darling. Am I not enough?

Nixie

(Nixie runs to Water and throws his arms around her.)
Yes ... but

Water

But what? Do not make trouble.

Sini

Sons must leave their mothers.

(Little Nixie is replaced by Teen Nixie)

For ten more years he swam beside her And she taught him

Water
Billows
Whirlwinds
Dripping, dropping

Teen Nixie
Swirls
Typhoons
roaring, roiling
Gurgling, burbling

Bathe, baptize, cascading Burst

In your lore I've been immersed. Now that I know all these things Won't you tell me who's my father?

You haven't yet perfected swishing And your undulating's choppy

I am tired of trying to copy. Let me go a wander.

No!

6. Nixie's Anger Dance, occasionally shouting percolate, pound, plunge or whip.)

Sini

Yet he remained.

(Teen Nixie is replaced by adult Nixie)
for ten more years,
till floating on his back one night
viewing stars and planets
he dreamt he rose above himself
to join the living constellations.

Pulsing, throbbing, multitudes, reverberating pitter-patter,

Deep Reverberating Male Voice

Nixie, Nixie

Sini

Divine Bear knew him by name. Nixie recognized his father.

Nixie

I must leave you, Mother.

Water

No! (her voice changes from defiant protest to acceptance within the one word)

Sini

Yes.

7. Nixie's Birth

Water

I tried to keep him underwater. tried to keep him with me.

Nixie

She kept me with her underwater Thirty summers under the sea.

Sini

Thirty summers under the sea!

Never did he see the sunlight
Nor behold the golden moonlight.
And the winters also thirty
How, unborn, to live and flourish?
How to live and flourish.

Nixie

Take me, Moon, I pray, take me.
O take me, sun above me.
From this dark and liquid place
O take me now O Bear of Heaven

Water Nixie

Bursts he through the outer portal Escapes my blue and purple jail On his knees he finds the air.

On my knees I leave the ocean Stand in golden moonlit air So I may see Heaven's Bear

Sini and Water:

Burst

Now I must leave her Forsake

Escape Forsake will walk upon two legs

Now I will flourish will walk upon two legs

Sini

Thus the wonderful enchanter
Was delivered from his mother
For the second time

Water

Oh, Nixie Have you no heart? How can you forsake me? (Sobbing, she subsides to the floor.)

Sini

Come, now, Nixie, Flex your muscles Show us what you can do.

Nixie

From island to inland to mountaintop I spread the seeds, I sow the forest

8. Green World

Sini

Fir trees Pine trees
Birches Shrubs
In the lowlands
Loose soil of the moist earth
On the banks of streams
Junipers and mountain ash
Fir trees, pine trees, birches shrubs
The plants are populated
The Green World is created.
created populated created

Nixie

Fir trees pine trees birches shrubs
In the lowlands loose soil of the moist earth

I sow upon the mountains and hilltops I sow in every valley and Marsh

On the banks of streams Junipers and mountain ash Fir trees pine trees birches shrubs I sow alders and lindens in hilly regions Willow and hawthorns in virgin places

Scene 2

Water

My own Nixie, son of water
Has forsaken me
These many years he's lived upon land.
Look, he's become an old man!

Nixie (now an old man with a long beard, sings)
On the plains of Kalevala

Sini and Nixie

Singing in the dusk of evening Singing till the dawn of morning

Water

Sings the legends of creation Tales of ages long forgotten. Nixie's become an old man.

Nixie, oh, my prodigal son, Remember when you sang with me? It's time to return to the sea.

Nixie

(mockingly) Do I hear a brook babbling?

All these years I've been a hero, leaped where others didn't dare Now I rest upon my laurels, play the zither, sing the stories in harmony with Divine Bear.

Sini

Far away in dismal Northland Lives the singer, Joukahainen. We will call him Yo.

Once upon a time when feasting
(You and Aino come onstage with stemmed goblets for the dragonfly and themselves.)
Dining with us, bug and sister
Comes upon his ears this story

Aino

Brother, listen, such a story, It's said there lives a sweeter singer, sweeter yet than Yo on the plains of Kalevala.

Sini

Aino, you are such a lovely sister, why would you provoke your brother. Causing him to boil and blister.

Aino

Truth be told ... I'm bored. It's so easy to provoke him by a bit of harmless teasing.

9. The Bard of Lapland

Nixie

I am the mythic monster Murdered by man

Yo

I am the bard of Lapland and I sing the best. I will go to Kalevala and put Nixie to the test.

Aino

Don't go, brother. Here we love you. Don't go brother, he will trick you.

Yo

You don't think I will win.

Aino

Your chances are quite slim.

Yo

If you loved me You'd support me.

Aino

I'm afraid of losing you.

Yo

You don't think that I'll win. My song will transform him, turn his feet to stone.

Aino

He'll turn your feet to clay! You'll walk home backward all the way. Oh, dear brother, beautiful singer, here we love you. Please do stay!

Don't take your songs away. Oh brother, please do stay!

Yo

Oh, dear sister, you don't believe me. If you believed in me you would let me go.

Aino

Yo

Oh, please don't go!

I sing the best!

You'll fail the test! Don't take your songs away.

I am the Bard of Lapland

Please don't go away. Don't take your songs away, Please don't' go away. I'll challenge Nixie to a test! I am the Bard of Lapland. I will prove that I'm the best.

Sini

Heeding not his sister's words He's going to the stable. She follows close behind To stop him if she's able.

Sini (Yo mounts his hobby horse. Aino throws up her hands, grabs the goblets and exits.)

Mounts impetuous his horsie

Strikes his courser with his birch whip.

Water

All day long and the next day Till the third day Sini

he gallops onward and the next. twilight brings him

All but Nixie
To the plains of Kalevala

Urging still his foaming courser Dashes down upon the singer

Does not turn aside in meeting Meeting then in full collision

(Yo gallops full speed at Nixie, who doesn't turn aside. They collide and land on the ground.)

All

Ouch-a-Kal-a-ouch-a-vala!

Nixie

(slowly picking himself up off the floor.) Who the hell are you?

Yo

(springing to his feet.) I am youthful You Know Who.

Nixie

Hoo hoo hoo!

Yo

I know you Knock knock, who's there Sorcerer, minstrel, Divine Bear. Let us now begin our singing. Challenge the other till the dawn. Let us sing our ancient legends In a war of wizard-song.

(Yo circles Nixie, striking poses. Nixie ignores him. Yo strikes pose, sings grandiloquently)

10. Yo Boast Song

Every roof must have a chimney
Fireplace a hearthstone
Salmon do love the river's bend.
Whitings do live in the quiet shallows.

Nixie

Boo hoo, You.
Women's tales and children's wisdom
Do not thrill an old greybeard.
Tell the story of creation.

Water and Sini

Tell us of the world's beginning Give us some philosophy.

Yo (strutting to build himself up)
I was present as a hero
When heaven was created
When was arched the beauteous rainbow

Water Liar!	Nixie	Sini
Liai:	Liar!	Liar!
Thou wert never seen or heard of		
	Lord of all the hosts of liars!	when the world was created
Loser!	Loser!	
		Loser!

Yo

(Humbly) Then, sir, since I fail in wisdom (Very angrily) With the sword I offer battle. (draws sword, assumes position.)

Water and Sini Nixie You

Nixie, sing you now enchantment

11. Quicksand

Nixie I sing You into Quicksand

(Nixie sings wordlessly. Sini begins wrapping Yo like a mummy in brown gauze up to his knees. Yo struggles but is unable to free himself.)

(spoken) I hate quicksand! Cease I pray thee this enchantment I will pay a golden ransom.

Nixie

For thy gold I have no longing I have all the wealth I need (more wordless singing)

Water

Deeper into mud and water Deeper into slough of torment Sorrow laden, thus enchanted Fear-enchained, full of anguish In the mire, beard bedrabbled Mouth once boastful full of seaweed

(Sini wraps Yo up to his chin.)

Yo

Only turn away thy magic Lift me from this stifling torment Clear my eyes of mud and water I will give thee ...

Sini

What will you give?

I will give thee

Nixie

What will you give me?

I will give thee Sister Aino.

(Long dramatic scream from offstage continuing until Aino arrives to face Yo and Nixie.)

Aino

(to Yo) Who are you to offer me? (Yo cowers)
(Nixie embraces her but she pushes away.) Who are you to take me prisoner?
My spirit will be free!

Water

Yes, you shall be free. Come, my lovely daughter-in-law, You can live with me. (Offers her hand.)

Nixie

I offer you a beautiful home All will be love within rainbows above and diamonds below I can offer ... children!

Aino

Seriously? You are old.

Yo

I will keep you safe from harm
I too have lots of money
I offer the hearth that you know, that you love

Aino

That, my dear brother, is funny.
You think you know just what I want.
How's this, here's that, and I must choose.
What if I want to be a Queen
and maybe, if I'm in the mood, I'll offer you a choice or two.
(looks at Nixie, looks at Yo, takes Water's hand)
I will live with Water.

Aino

Into the sea

Water

Into the water

I will be your daughter.

(Aino disappears with Water, who calls back to them.)
You will not see her again.

You and Nixie

Aino! (They began sobbing dramatically on each other's shoulders.)

Sini

From their tears come the rivers, come the birches, come the cuckoos,

who still sing these songs of sorrow.

(Nixie begins to move off.) **Yo**Nixie, Brother in Sorrow, you're not planning on leaving me in quicksand, are you?

Nixie

Rot in Hell. (He runs to the end of the stage after Water and Aino.) Aino was my destiny.

Sini

This has turned into a mess.

(to Yo) Still, you're quite a handsome guy.

Let us strike a compromise:

I will let you out of the muck

but

you'll be a dragonfly.

(12. Transformation in background while Sini begins unwinding Yo)

Yo A buo

A bug?

Sini

A dragon. With wings.

Yo

Will I fly?

Sini

Yes.

Yo

And then...I will die.

Sini

Yes.

Well. It's possible we will mate.

And then you'll die.

But don't worry.

Dragonflies have perfected the art of resurrection.

At first it feels like you are dead You sink beneath the veil.

Then it comes, an inner impulse Sweeping you from head to tail (Sini finishes unwinding as Yo shivers violently)

Yo

I break forth from the veil! (he does) But wait, I'm just a naiad.

Sini (attaching wings)
Be patient my friend,
You are not in control.
Naids become dragons
In translucent plates of mail.
These wings are wet but they will dry.

Dragonflies

A living flash of light we fly!

13. Dragonfly Dance:

(They fly around. Perhaps mating. Nixie returns, very angry.)

Nixie (calls after Water)

Mother!

For thirty years I was your minnow
Swimming in your shadow.

Till burst I forth, the hero, Nixie!

From island to inland to mountaintop I spread the seeds, I sowed the forest

14. Victory

Dragonflies

Fir trees, Pine trees, Birches, Shrubs

Nixie

There was just one thing I didn't know The love of beauteous Aino!

How can I be a hero without (groans in agony)

You won the victory. You've had your revenge. I can never more be happy. Mother, this is not the end!

(Child comes on laughing. Nixie wraps himself in water. Child sticks a toe in water. Nixie splashes her. They play. Nixie beckons and lures her into the water. The lights go purple as he drowns her.

15. Funeral

A funeral occurs underwater with Dragonfly flitting above, sobbing. Music fades out. Nixie and child exit. Lights up. Aino comes on.

Aino (very upset)
Why did he drown the beautiful child? She wanted to live!

Water

He's angry. Heros do stupid things when they're angry, Sometimes they become villains.

Aino

What about me?
You think I'm not angry?
I got to choose between a man who drowns children and Underwater Mama.
I might as well be ...

16. No One Believes

Water Aino

Once you've drowned you can never return

Once you've drowned you can never return never return

(Spoken) That is why a mother, nowadays, before her children go into the water says (Sung) Nixie out of the water, children into the water.

(Spoken) And when the children are done swimming she says (Sung) Nixie into the water, children out of the water.

Both: So the children are always protected.

(Looks around warily.) Where is Nixie now?

Water

No one knows.

Aino

No one cares.

No one believes this story anymore.

No one believes these stories anymore.

(Lights fade out.)

Scene 3

Sini

And so Death entered the green world.

Folks thought it was natural.

They said we've seen this before.

Nothing really dangerous, just another metaphor.

(Lights up to dim blue. Water and Aino are underwater.)

Water

The blue world isn't happy either.
I used to be a Goddess,
A powerful Creator.
Now I'm just an element.
A has-been second-rater.

Aino

(Lets out a long sigh/yawn/groan.)
Underwater is boring.

Water

It's *fine* underwater, it's actually *better* underwater. (Sighs) Remember, you are free.

Aino

But

(frustrated) I would trade some freedom
for a little more friction,
I'll give you swirly swills and swails
For some interdiction.

(yearning) I want to walk beneath the trees,
milk some cows and plant some seeds,
kiss a man and dance and play.
Could you give me just one day?
Just one day out of the water?

(Water sighs, lifts the edge of water, the lights come up full, and Aino crawls, giddy with happiness and begins to skip about.)

17. Queen Song
Aino
I am walking
walking outside
outside

(music repeats phrase, creatures buzz the melody as they dance)

Sini and Yo Dragon

with the busy bugs

Water

Blub blub blub blub

All

La la la la

(music repeats phrase, creatures buzz the melody as they dance)

Aino

Busy bugs are marvelous things

Dragonflies

Are marvelous things

All

Are marvelous things.

(a small Nixie tumbles across stage)

Aino

Something odd Went tumbling by

Yo Dragon

a little tornado

Sini

or large tumbleweed.

Aino

I'm absorbed with making myself perfect
I give no mind

(Nixie appears on stage)

Dragonflies

The thing returns.

Aino

I give no mind.

Dragonflies

Now it is bigger!

Aino

I do not care! I'm full of grand thoughts. And poetry.

(Nixie exits. Aino and Dragonflies dance. Music resolves. Lights fade to black.)

Scene 4

(Lights up on Nixie, center stage. Three dragonflies occasionally appear.)

18. Mythic Monster

Nixie

I am the mythic monster, murdered by men, resurrected by children.

(Aino enters. IgnoresNixie.)

I will seduce this one, Queen of all she surveys.

Am I furry?
Am I fast?
Scales that shimmer,
Fangs that flash.

Do you worry?
A little doubt,
a large regret lurks in your eyes
better look out.
(Lights fade.)

Scene 5

(Lights up. Nixie is hiding behind Water – he can be seen by audience. Aino enters, look around.)

19. Seduction

Nixie: Aino:

Good. He's gone.

I'm a thing that likes to play Guess where I am.

Probocis.

Just a nose.

Incisors. And anticoagulants.

Water and Dragonflies

This is going in the wrong direction.

(Nixie offers Aino his hand. She accepts it. He leads her into a wild dance, the whirls her around as Aino gasps or screams.. Lights fade.)

Scene 6

(Lights up on Nixie wearing a sheer detachable cape. Aino can be seen inside. Music. They dance in sync. Nixie is tired, he keeps trying to sit them down on a wheeled cart but Aimo refuses.)

Aino

What's the matter, monster? Are you tired? You wanted me, you got me, now you've got to dance!

Nixie

We've been dancing two thousand years
The floor is puddled by your tears
And riddled by our constant tread
the world we knew has gone to bed.
It no longer exists.

Aino

What?

Dragonflies (a repeated, whispered chant)

Fear Panic Crisis Alone in a riot

Aino

The fir trees?

Dragonflies (slightly louder)

Fear Panic Crisis Alone in Fear
Panic Crisis Alone in a riot

Nixie

Gone

Aino

No birches, no pine trees?

Nixie

Shrubs, maybe.

Aino

Why didn't you tell me? This is horrible! What happened to the Green World?

Nixie

Betrayed.

Dragonflies

Fear Panic Crisis Alone in a riot

Aino (She sinks down and they sit on the wheeled cart back-to-back.)

Do you know what I wish?

Nixie

You want to go back in time. Join the club. (He yawns, falls asleep.)

Kati

Psst! Aino! We bring news!

Aino

I already know. The Green World has been destroyed.

Yo Dragon

Listen: you really are a Queen. You have power!

Aino

What nonsense. I'm trapped! If only I hadn't been so ...

20. Curiosity Aino

Curiosity, curiosity,
Now I live inside a monstrosity
Isn't it rich? Isn't it rich?
I'm in a monster that doesn't exist.

Dragonflies:

Glaciers melt, waters warm Children die, no insects swarm. All is harm, all is harm. Woe woe is me Woe, woe are we.

Glaciers melt, waters warm. Children die, no insects swarm. Woe, woe, woe, woe, Woe woe, woe, woe, Woe woe are we!

Aino:

Alas, I was thinking of my self
And no one else, nothing else did matter.
I neglected my precious elements,
The land, the sea, the air!

You tell me of my power.

I feel it, I know it.

What good is my power
When I'm stuck in here?
Woe is me, woe is me.

Dragonflies:

We must try to set you free. How are we to set you free?

Aino and Dragonflies:

Woe, woe are we.

Water:

Freedom is a state of mind. If you are brave, you will be free.

Dragonflies

What good is bravery when you're stuck inside a mythic monster?

Water

Dragonflies, you have bright ideas
Then you flitter flutter
If you want Aino to be released
You must make a sacrifice.
Let's find out what you're made of.

Wait, you really are a Queen?

Aino

So they say.

Dragonflies

Let the old myth fall away. Queen, we need a her-story. We need to save the world.

Aino

Hmm

Maybe we can time travel, Return to the Kalevala, Where plants are populated.

All

Where we are re-created.

(Nixie awakes.) **Nixie**Why is everyone looking at me?

21. Chorale Dragonflies

O, great and powerful monster, hear our humble plea.

If we complete an impossible task,

Would you release, would you release our Queen?

I've always wanted to go on a quest.

Sini

(to Nixie) But...

you don't have four corners and I don't have words If I found them, how would they stick?

Nixie

Just shut up and go on your quest! (turns so that only Aino can watch the action.)

(Dragonflies and Water put on swim goggles. Water gets on cart.)

You Dragon

I hope this quest is fun,

Kati

I hope it's fun for me.

Both

It will be fun to solve the mystery..

Water

(Water swims back and forth across the stage on her wheeled cart. First sitting comfortably. When the music pauses she gets into different swimming positions.)

Follow the Water. Listen to the Water Water remembers Water speaks.

(Dragonflies follow Water back and forth across stage, beating their wings frantically. Water and the Dragonflies become covered with black oil.)

Sini

Water, where did you lead me?
I'm getting frantic.
Look where Water did lead me,
from _____ (place of performance) to the Atlantic.

(Now Water and Dragonflies are covered with sediment, which sticks to the oil coating)

Kati

Yuck! What's this stuff?

Aino

Just tiny bits of rock and soil. It's natural.

Little Dragonfly

But it stinks.

Aino

Possibly poo poo.

Simi

Yo, Kati.

My wings are oiled and heavy.

I don't think I'm going to make it.

Promise me you'll carry on

if I die before we're done

Yo

Um. I'm not really a dragonfly ...

Kati

I promise to fullfill the quest. I will never give up.

Sini

My wings are oiled
I'm terribly tired
Water leads me past the Atlantic
To the North Sea.

(Water and Dragonflies are weirdly glowing and near dead.)

Aino

Wow, cool. How do you make yourselves glow like that?

You Dragon

Nuclear waste.

Sini

To the North Sea from the Atlantic
I followed Water to the Baltic.
Now I have to rest.
(Looks at Water, shoves her off the cart and sits down.)
I hope this ends my quest.

(Nixie/Aino appears.)

Nixie

Sini

You look a little worse for wear.

You're looking at a hero.

You look like you don't have much longer.

Kati

Seven more days at least.

Did you find words for my four corners?

Yo

We rounded the square We followed the water

Kati and Yo DragonWe followed ourselves
We are the water.

Aino

You did it!

Nixie Prove it!
