



SHOULD MY CHILD GO TO SCHOOL TODAY?

Is your child (vaccinated or unvaccinated) believed to have been in contact with an individual who tested positive for COVID-19 ?

- Have child take a test before coming to school (at-home tests accepted) and email a picture of the results to health@yscp.org.
- If negative, child can come to school masked for 10 days and contact the nurse for further instructions.
- If positive, child needs stay home.

Do you (whether vaccinated or unvaccinated) have **any** of the following symptoms not related to chronic allergies or illness:

Temperature of 100 degrees Fahrenheit or higher
 Difficulty breathing/shortness of breath
 Cough
 New loss of taste or smell
 Sore throat
 Congestion or runny nose
 Headache
 Diarrhea
 Vomiting or nausea
 Muscle or body aches

- Inform the school.
- Take a test before coming to school (at-home test accepted) and email a picture of the results to health@yscp.org.
- If negative, child can come to school as long as fever free for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.
- If positive, child needs stay home.

- At least 5 days have passed since symptoms first appeared
