A: I would say I would regret not going for president but overall I still like it.


Q: What do you think about the people in middle school? A: I think we can be more respectful to our teachers, students, and higher-ups.

Q: Why did you wanna teach music? Mrs. H: I loved music and performing music, I think it makes kids smarter like another foreign language


Q: do you like this school and what's their biggest flaw? Mrs. Bella: I love working here their biggest flaw is not enough of me to go around


























Betty Riddles
