- Baritone/Euphonium




Service as Action!


Klara and Kaylyn are working on a great service as action project! Together they are raising money to get materials that are needed for homeless people. They need YOUR help to spread the word!




Yearbook Staff-Writing with Kindness

Q: What are your 3 best traits?


A: Positive, sarcasm and stickers:)

A: Because I subbed a lot when my son was in kindergarten and I just applied for a job as a teacher here cause I spent so much time here.


Q: What are your 3 best traits?

A: Yes. They have the potential to be.





