Cobra Pilot Who Lifted

On Tuesday, President of the United States Joe Biden awarded Capt. Larry Taylor, a Vietnam war pilot, with the medal of honor for his bravery by flying his attack helicopter into heavy enemy gunfire, until he ran out of ammunition. He then led a rescue team for a small group soldiers who'd been left for dead.

On the date of June 18, 1968, a long distance Reconpatrol team of four soldiers were about to be overrun by 100+ Vietcong soldiers.

Taylor, a little northeast of Saigon, reached the battleground flying one of the two AH-1G Cobra helicopters. He shot rockets and mini guns at the advancing enemy for nearly an hour, trying to clear the way and buy time for the rescue helicopter, but the rescue attempt was too dangerous. They believed the rescue craft would be shot down and the four man team would be killed.

Taylor's helicopter was so badly damaged it was at a major risk of losing functions. He was told to retreat but he deliberately disobeyed the order.

Taylor initiated his own VERY risky rescue operation all while still flying his heavily battle damaged two manned attack helicopter.

"It's incredible. How he refused to give up, refused to leave a fellow American behind. ... When duty called, Larry did everything to answer," said President Biden, at the White House ceremony. Taylor was at the ceremony on Tuesday when president Biden draped the highest military award you can receive around his neck.

Taylor flew more than 2,000 combat missions in the Cobra and UH-1 helicopters and was actually FORCED down by enemy fire five times. He worked for a roofing and sheet metal company after his army service in Tennessee, where he and his wife live to this day.

The Recon Team fired a flare to alert Taylor and to hopefully avoid friendly fire but also ended up alerting the Vietcong of their position, starting more intense and precise attacks. The enemies were so close that the helicopters were reportedly firing right in front of the Reconnaissance team.

The troops were sent to a clearing so the helicopter could pick them up. Normally, the procedure would be friendly, but soldiers lay down to take cover from fire while the Recon team climbs aboard, but the Cobra fired its last few minigun bursts just before.

Doing all the maneuvers of an attack run, Taylor flew his Cobra toward the North Vietnamese soldiers to draw their attention unknowingly to the Vietnamese. He was out of ammunition and no longer a threat giving the Reconnaissance team, in time to escape.

"He drew the enemy fire himself, tricking the enemy into thinking he still had ammo," Biden said.

Taylor, with his bullet hole infested helicopter landed to get the Recon team there a small problem presented itself, because a Cobra has no cargo space for passengers. The Recon team had to grab onto the rocket holders and skids, where another problem popped out. If they flew all the way back to base, the skids and rocket holders would've frozen, so they just went to a safe location from which the team made their way back on foot.

"He rewrote the fate of four families for generations to come," Biden said. "That's valor; that's our nation at its very best."



Nebraska National Guard Troops That Have Been Sent To Border Expected To Return Home This Week by Asa & Jaxon

The gov. of Nebraska Jim Pillen stated Saturday that the Nebraskan national guard is to return home on Friday from the U.S - Mexico border is where they were sent last month on August 2nd to assist the authorities trying to counter illegal immigration and drug trafficking.

The 61 soldiers have been stationed in Texas to provide "additional observation and reporting near the border", assisting the law enforcement involved with Operation Lone Star.

Texas gov. Greg Abbott of the Republican Party started Lone Star in March of 2021, deploying resources and people from the Texas Department Of Safety and the Texas National Guard in an attempt to secure the area.

Nebraska is one of the 14 states that have sent resources to Texas in aid of the operation The other states include Arkansas, Florida, Iowa, Idaho, North Dakota, Ohio, Oklahoma, South Carolina, South Dakota, Tennessee, Virginia, West Virginia and Texas.

Last month's deployment marked the fourth time a Nebraska governor. Has sent troops to the border and it's the second time this year.

Pillen defended the cost of \$2.6 mil which is the price of this summers deployments according to the states budget director lee will after visiting the border with Nebraska National Guard Adj. Gen. Craig Strong last week.

"Based on what I saw today, the cost of the two recent deployments of National Guard troops and State Patrol troopers is worth the prevention of having illegal drugs and criminals pour through the southern border at ever-increasing numbers each day," said Pillen during his trip.







it.


Raybearer Review by Ms. Lemoine






Favorite Music Genres By: Logan




