Accordingly we have had to reduce the discount previously offered from 76.8% to 46.0%. We have, on the other hand, been able to pass along a savings of \$13.86 on the shipping costs. The net result, based on the previous shipment to 66 of your members, is an invoice total of \$348.10 compared with the last invoice amount of \$214.30. It should be noted that the annual cost to each of your members is pre-tax \$20.00 compared with the annual non-member subscription price of \$25.00.
