

MAIN BEACH BOAT LAUNCH  
HERITAGE LAKE

**General:** Heritage Lake is near Whiteswan Lake. Leisure walk in dive with reasonable visibility year round, a short swim to 25 foot depths. Lots of marine life in the weed beds.

**Phones:** Pay phone at Whiteswan Lake Lodge or Minawaka Beach at Candle Lake.

**Services and Amenities:** Overnight camping may or may not be permitted at Heritage Lake. Candle Lake or Whiteswan Lake may be a substitute. Government boat launch and dock. Washrooms on site.

**Directions to Dive Site:** Heritage lake is a small lake 30 kms north of Candle Lake on highway 913 leading off of highway 120, 107 kms north of Prince Albert. Drive past Candle Lake on highway 120 onto highway 913 to Heritage Lake boat launch and campsite turnoff. Park in campsites and walk to dive site entrance.

**Diver Experience Level:**

**Entry and Exit Points:** Off main boat launch dock on either side along the beach. Good sharp drop off to the dive site.

**Underwater Information:**

- **Depths** Bottom drop off is 25 feet. Maximum depth of 50 feet.
- **Hazards** Boaters from the boat launch. Always use dive flags.
- **Visibility** Spring 25-30 feet. Summer 20-25 feet. Fall and winter 20-30 feet.

- **Comments** Heritage lake is a well-known dive site in the northern part of Saskatchewan due mostly to its good visibility and good depths close to shore. The lake is used extensively in the spring for the open water training of newly certified students. If you're lucky you may find the sunken Mazda car close to the main dock (right side) just off the drop-off in 25 feet of water.
