General: Whelan bay is located on Whiteswan Lake near Meath Park. Whiteswan Lake is a large lake 50 kms north of Candle Lake on highway 913 leading off highway 120 and 127 north of Prince Albert. Dive site has to be accessed by a boat.

Phones: Pay phone at Whiteswan Lake Lodge. Camping and cabin rentals can be arranged through the lodge. Good boat launch and dock.

Directions to Dive Site: From the main floating dock go to a rock point on the southwest shore of Whelan Bay, first point west of Mystery Lake. There is a 3 foot diameter rock with a white arrow pointing to the direction of the bell (usually marked with a buoy).

Underwater Information:

- **Depths** Sail boat at 45 feet. Diving bell at 53 feet.
- **Hazards** Moderate boat traffic, always use a dive flag.
- **Visibility** 25-40 feet year round.

- **Underwater Attractions** Navigation dive out to several man placed artifacts. 7-foot diameter dive bell, sunken sail boat, toilet, snow machine hood etc.
- **Comments** Whiteswan Lake is known as one of the clearest lakes in Saskatchewan accessible to divers. It offers excellent diving to a maximum of 149 feet in a variety of different locations. Most of the greater depths are on the other side of the lake and only accessible by boat. The lodge offers boat rentals at a reasonable rate and also manages a 8" by 16" flat deck pontoon boat, which is available to divers at a reasonable rate.
