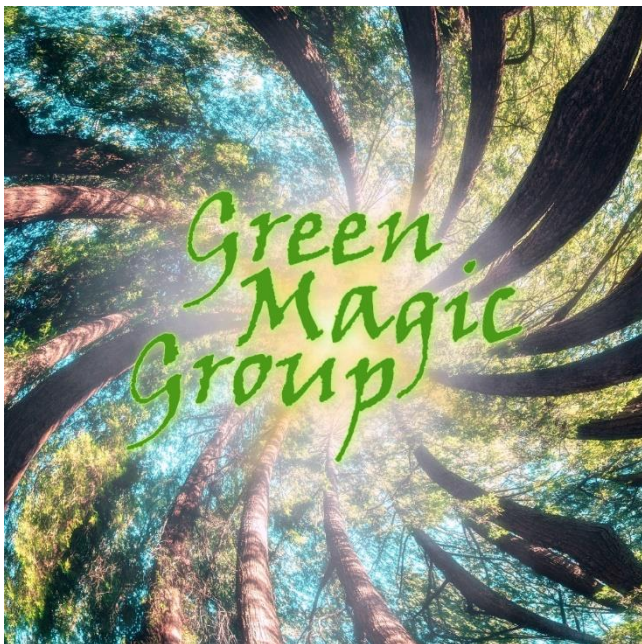
May Update

Did you know?

A standard 16-foot Trex board contains recycled material from approximately 2,250 plastic bags and lasts 20-40 years! The average 500-square-foot composite Trex deck contains over 140,000 recycled plastic bags, films, and wraps. The entire high-performance Trex decking portfolio is manufactured using more than 95% recycled content.



What we must do ...

1. Collect grocery bags, pallet shrink wrap, bread bags, case overwraps, dry cleaning bags, newspaper sleeves, zip lock or resealable food bags, produce bags, product wrap, retail bags, air pillows & bubble wrap, plastic shipping envelopes, cracker and cereal bags, plastic #2 or #4 films, mattress bags, etc.
2. Weigh your collected materials (we have scales and collection bins available in the Fellowship Hall at URV), take a photo of your collected materials, and log the date and weight. Send that info to urvofficemanager@yahoo.com, and we'll post it online.
3. Take your collected materials to a participating film and bag recycling partner. We can drop off at Food Lion, Harris Teeter, Kohl's, Kroger, or Target.
4. Find a place to put our bench!
