long since forgotten.




Just a 20-minute drive from the delightful, historic town of Bury St Edmunds, Mill House is a 400-year-old timber framed cottage set in the rural Suffolk countryside on the edge of the village of Badwell Ash. Having lovingly restored and re-envisioned a true representation of our English heritage to become our home in 2014, we rejoice in the privilege of being custodians of this listed building.





Having spent four decades of our married life training, equipping and envisioning young and not so young people who have gone on to become leaders in many spheres of the Kingdom of God, we are now the pioneers of a different kind of equipping ministry. Legacy Leadership provides a safe space for leaders in a variety of spheres of influence to gather bi-monthly to listen, share and develop their Godly call. This includes follow up mentoring to ground the teaching and prayer in between gatherings.

The next stage of our call is to offer our home and what will soon become the "Legacy Barn" to extend the ministry of Legacy Leadership to all leaders who have a dream, need a dream, or need an old dream re-kindled. The Legacy Barn will provide opportunities for people to come and enjoy the calm and space, and give them the opportunity to dream again with God.

Mill House captivated us by its obvious potential on our first visit. We imagined how

the outbuildings could become a safe place, somewhere to host people and events, and provide a retreat from life's usual rhythms into a place full of God's presence.

We've always been people with open doors, welcoming family and friends, those we have mentored and visiting ministers. We made our house a home for those who needed one, be it for a few nights, a few weeks, or even longer, and our passion for hospitality has made our dining table a place for people to talk, cry, share stories, pour out their heart, receive revelation, and pray.

Our more than four decades of experience in ministry, including planting and bolstering churches, has given us something unique to share with those looking for a retreat. Visitors to Mill House are captivated by its ambience, peaceful setting, sense of a home saturated in prayer, a great night's sleep and home-cooked food.



We confess at times it seemed impossible, yet we now live in a beautifully restored cottage with modern facilities that still retain the character and charm of its history.

It is our prayer that what happened on the land physically now has a spiritual significance for the way God is asking us to hold the vision in this space for leaders.

The dream is even more vivid than ever, and thanks to our amazing architect we have drawings and plans of what the physical representation of that dream will become.

In 2016, we had to withdraw our initial plan for the barn, and after a two-year pause, we felt God urging us to proceed during our 2018 sabbatical. Miraculously, we received funding for necessary surveys and connected with an architect who began developing our plans, incorporating the old mill stock in addition to the barn itself.

Despite delays due to COVID-19, we finally secured planning permissions by early 2021, and by March 2023 we felt God had given us the green light – the gift of faith to "rise up and build", and from then the Legacy Dream Barn has begun to take shape.

This project represents significant investment and faith, literally sowing into the ground for a greater purpose.



WAY FORWARD

As of October 2024 we have the foundations of a building and the plans and permissions to go ahead.

In July we invited friends and family to join us as we celebrated Trevor's 70th, 50yrs since we met and Susie's official retirement, which we are calling reFIREment as we believe God has big plans for us.

The Legacy Dream Barn is a vehicle for achieving those new challenges and opportunities, and we have been encouraged by many of those that joined us to believe it is a key part of God's plan and have already become a part of this journey.

Previous estimates of the cost of construction by contractors have been in the region of £200,000. A recent revised estimate based on a self-managed build, utilising friends and contacts with a wide range of different skills and abilities, would potentially bring the estimate to complete down to nearer £150,000.

Financially, we have already put £35,000 into the project as a whole with currently a further £15,000 to get us started. Because we are both past pensionable age taking a conventional mortgage to finance the remainder of the build is no longer an option, despite our home being worth c£500,000 with no mortgage. We have also looked into equity release schemes however, whilst most of those do not release funds for building projects, that could be a means of repaying other shorter term loans once the build is completed.

Just to be clear, we are not a registered charity, and the barn cannot be sold as a separate dwelling from the main house. We are therefore looking for a very small number of major investors who can share our vision to see the barn in operation for the building of God's Kingdom and His servants.
