How to Make an Estimated Tax Payment to the IRS Online

You can pay your estimated taxes directly to the IRS online through their secure payment portal. Follow these steps:

Step 1: Go to the IRS Payment Page

- Visit <u>irs.gov/payments</u>
- You can pay directly from your bank account (ACH) for free
- If you choose to pay with a credit or debit card, a processing fee will apply

Step 2: Select the "Direct Pay" Option

- Click the blue button labeled:
 - "Direct Pay with Bank Account"

Step 3: Choose the Payment Type

- Click the link that says:
 - "Pay Individual Tax"

Step 4: Start the Payment Process

- Under the **"Pay Personal Taxes"** section, click the blue button:
 - "Make a Payment"

Step 5: Fill Out the Payment Details for Estimated Taxes

On the next screen, you'll be asked to select from three dropdown menus:

- Reason for Payment: Select "Estimated Tax"
- Apply Payment To: Select "1040ES (for 1040, 1040A, 1040EZ)"
- Tax Period for Payment: Select "2025"

Then click Continue

Step 6: Verify Your Identity

- You'll need to verify your identity using information from a prior-year tax return (typically 2023)
- Fill in the requested details and click Continue

Step 7: Finalize the Payment

- Follow the remaining prompts to complete your payment
- You will receive a confirmation once the payment has been submitted successfully
