



Greetings, Dancers and Dance Families!

North Pointe Ballet is excited that you will be performing with us for *Peter and the Wolf* on

April 13, 2025 at 2:00pm at JDBCAC!

Friday, April 11th - Dress Rehearsal

Arrive at your regularly scheduled class time.

Students will be providing their own dancewear for this performance including tights and ballet shoes. Please let us know if you need assistance getting these items.

Ballet 1 students playing “Peter’s Friends” should wear pink, either a leotard and skirt or dance dress of some kind. A flower headpiece will be provided for you from NPB.

Ballet 2 students should wear black, either a leotard and skirt, dance dress, or leggings and a tank top. Cat ears will be provided for you by NPB.

Arrive wearing your dancewear and tights and bring your ballet shoes with you.

Hair should be up in a bun or secured away from the face.

Students will practice their dance and go through the order of the performance in their costumes during their regular class time.

Take all costume pieces home with you for the performance the following Sunday.

Sunday, April 13th - Performance Day!

What to wear:

- Your class’s assigned dancewear (either pink or black)
- Borrowed headpiece from NPB
- Tights and Ballet Shoes (if you don’t have a pair, please let us know.)
- Hair secured away from face



1:30PM --Arrival

- Check in at the main entrance from the Parking lot
- Proceed to the basement and find your classmates and teachers.
- Change into your ballet shoes and take off any coats or warm up clothes you have on over your costume.

1:45PM -- Doors to Gym Open

- Families can find a seat in the audience.
- Anyone exhibiting cold or flu-like symptoms, please stay home

2:00PM --Performance

- Student dancers will sit together as a class in designated area to watch and be called up when it is their turn to perform
- Student dancers will demonstrate steps and skills they have worked on in class
- Company members will present “Peter and the Wolf” while student dancers sit in their designated area.
- Student dancers will be called up when it is their turn to perform with the professionals
- After their dance, students can return to their designated area in the audience and enjoy the remainder of the performance!

3:00PM -- Departure

- Feel free to take photos of your dancer and their friends! Professional dancers will be around for photos as well.
- **Any borrowed headpieces or shoes must be returned to NPB before departure.**
